Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS II) with 4 phthalate substances
Declaration of Compliance

May 1, 2024

The European Union Directive 2011/65/EC, Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS-II) amended with 2015/863/EU restricts the use of certain substances in electrical and electronic equipment (EEE). The directive limits the use of these 10 hazardous substances to the following maximum concentration limits shown below.

Cadmium	0.01%
Hexavalent Chromium	0.1%
Lead	0.1%
Mercury	0.1%
Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBBs)	0.1%
Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)	0.1%
Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)	0.1%
Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)	0.1%
Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)	0.1%
Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)	0.1%

Nationwide Circuits, Inc. has taken reasonable steps to ensure that our end products do not contain these substances. These measures include the requirement of a certification statement or declaration from all raw material suppliers or distributors stating that none of these substances, are added to, or known to be present in their products in concentrations higher than the limits set forth in the directive.
