

THE GOAL IS TO BE ABLE TO REMOVE YOUR OLD KEYPAD SWITCH FROM ITS PLASTIC BEZEL. CLEAN THE SURFACE OF ALL OLD ADHESIVE AND RESIDUE USING TAR REMOVER OR ISOPROPYL ALCHOL. LET DRY AND THEN INSTALL YOUR NEW KEYPAD.

CONTROL PANEL REMOVAL

 Remove screw from front door. Set aside door for serviceability.




- 2. Remove (4) screws from sides of control panel.
- Rotate control panel down until panel stops. Do not force.

NOTE: Caution must be used to not damage controls or wiring.
