

Greetings Prayer Team!

I trust you are doing well and that you're having a great 2026 so far.

I just got back from El Salvador Monday night and here's my report of what happened with the church we partnered with:

1. Having trained the disciple makers in advance, we went out with them and connected with unbelievers and prayed for the sick and presented the Gospel.
2. Our team began by demonstrating how to do it. By the end of the mission, the disciple makers took over, so they could carry it on once we left.
3. As people came to Christ, we formed new discipleship groups to go through our three books of the Great Commission movement of building, mobilizing, and winning:
 - o Book One – Essential Truths of the Christian Life
 - o Book Two – “Built” up in the Foundations of the Faith
 - o Book Three – “Mobilizing and Winning” others to Christ
4. Before leaving, we met with the pastor and disciple makers. They committed to disciple the new believer's each week until the three books of building, mobilizing, and winning were completed.
Then, these new Christians would become disciple makers who would learn how to heal the sick and preach the Gospel and go out and do it. They would establish their own groups and take their converts through the same discipleship process they went through. This is Christ's Great Commission movement - not just being discipled but becoming disciple makers.
5. As disciple makers are multiplied, so too is the growth of God's kingdom. This was our focus in El Salvador and for the other countries we're working in, for the glory of God.

So, here's what happened because you prayed for these requests from my last prayer letter:

1. **Request** - that God would protect our team physically while we travel to and from El Salvador and throughout the country
[No incidents. Praise the Lord!](#)
2. **Request** - that God would surround our team and our families with His angels of light, so we'd all be protected from the attacks of the enemy
[God answered this, too!](#)
3. **Request** - that each team member would be filled with God's power and authority to heal the sick and preach the Gospel
[God was faithful, resulting in a good number being healed and coming to Jesus. The pastor I trained, began healing and testifying after only three days, which was a transforming experience for him, along with the other disciple makers. Thanks for your prayers!](#)
4. **Request** - that people would be supernaturally healed and drawn to Christ.
[Here's a small sampling:](#)
[One lady believes she was healed of diabetes. After we prayed, she felt a power flow through her body from head to toe and her daughter next to her felt it too. Sensing something changed physically, she was certain that God had healed her. So much so, that she immediately accepted Christ as her Lord and Savior, whereas before her healing, she wasn't interested.](#)
[A fourteen-year-old girl named Karla, believes God healed her of a blood clot in her brain. Before we prayed, she had pain in the back of her head and couldn't rotate her neck in a circular motion. She was taking medications and experiencing some dizziness. After prayer, she felt something warm go through her head and neck area. She said the pain in her head completely disappeared. Not only that, she could also fully rotate her neck. But she was dizzy than before and couldn't stand. After another prayer, the dizziness](#)

vanished and she was able to get up and walk. With tears streaming down her face, she thanked God for what He had done.

An older man, Eduardo, had heart problems which restricted his breathing and caused physical weakness. After prayer, he felt a warm sensation flow through his chest, and he literally felt something moving in his heart. We asked him to try walking. He immediately felt more strength and could breathe normally. He declared that God had done a miracle in his life. This man was a devout Roman Catholic and initially had no interest in receiving Christ. But after God healed him, he did.

A young woman named Lady believes she was healed of chronic bronchitis. It had caused discomfort in her chest and difficulties breathing. She was also on medications that added some challenging side effects. After we prayed, she felt a warmth flow through her head and chest. Instantly, the discomfort left, and she could take deep breaths. She immediately put her faith in Jesus. On Sunday, she told me that she no longer has to take medications, as God had completely healed her.

5. **Request** - that God's Spirit would open people's hearts to accept the good news

In total, we saw 94 people come to Christ, many with tears streaming down their faces. Interestingly, a good number were already professing Christians. They believed in Jesus intellectually but had never surrendered control to Him. The last Sunday I spoke in church, ten more accepted Christ.

6. **Request** - that those who profess Christ would join a group and be discipled

About 75% of the new believers showed up for the first discipleship session in book one. This is our gauge for success, as the Great Commission is about making disciples, not just seeing people make decisions.

7. **Request** - that 11 new Great Commission discipleship groups would be planted

We ended up starting 36 new groups. However, the pastor's plan was to reduce the number to 21 by amalgamating some of them. Thanks for your prayers!

8. **Request** - that the disciple makers would follow through on their commitment to disciple their groups each week

At the last meeting of the week, they committed to do this.

9. **Request** - that the country leaders would hear from God as to next steps for equipping more churches in their respective countries

On this trip, our country leaders from Guatemala, Costa Rica and El Salvador were with us:

- Nick and Mayra from Costa Rica
- Pastor Juan and Katherin from Guatemala
- Alfredo and Elsa from El Salvador

Each presented a list of pastors who want us to come and launch Christ's Great Commission movement in their churches over the next few months. Thanks for praying, as there are now more churches wanting us to come than what we can currently accommodate.

10. **Request** - that God would raise the funds to cover the team member's trip expenses

God answered this prayer as well
