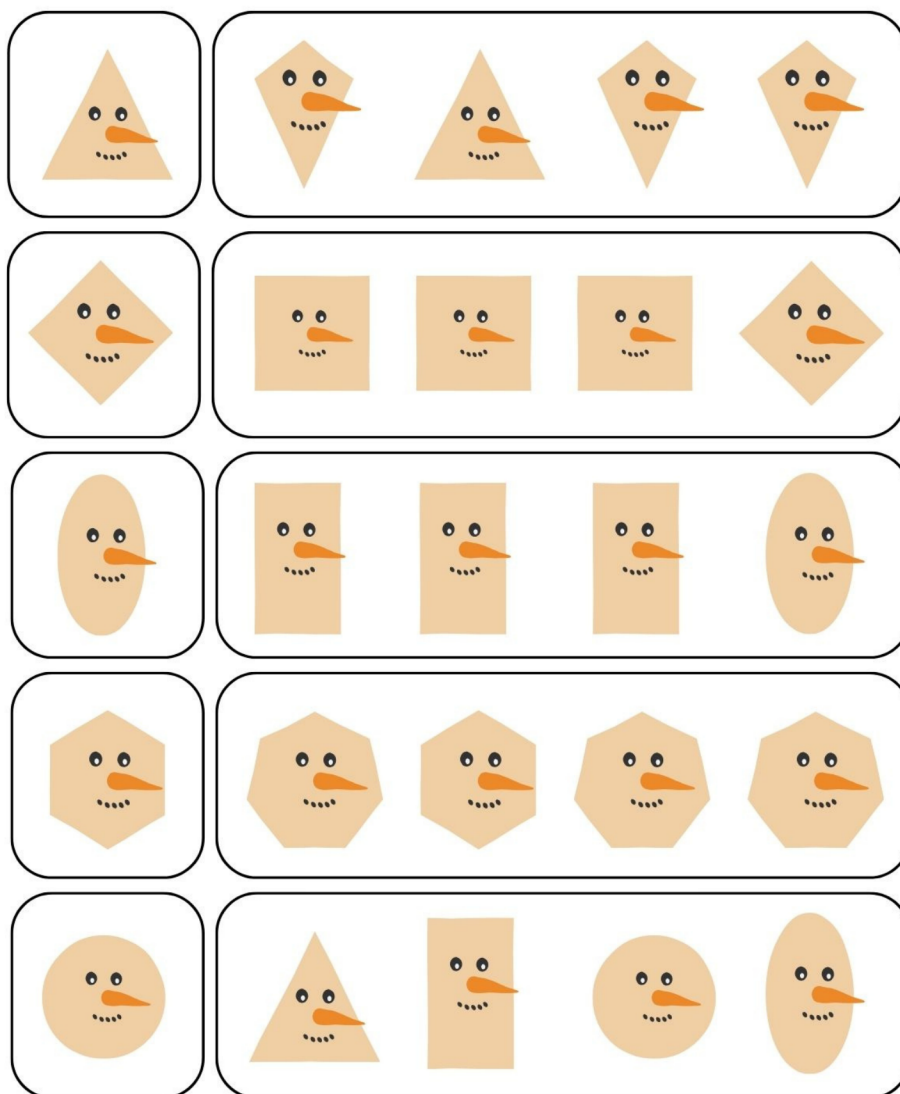


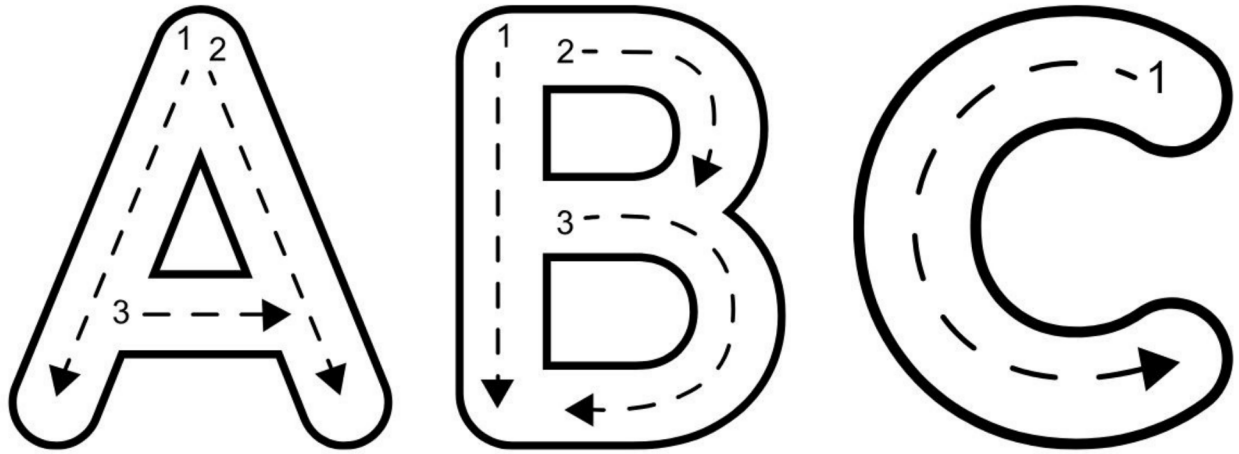
Complete the maze to practice drawing a square

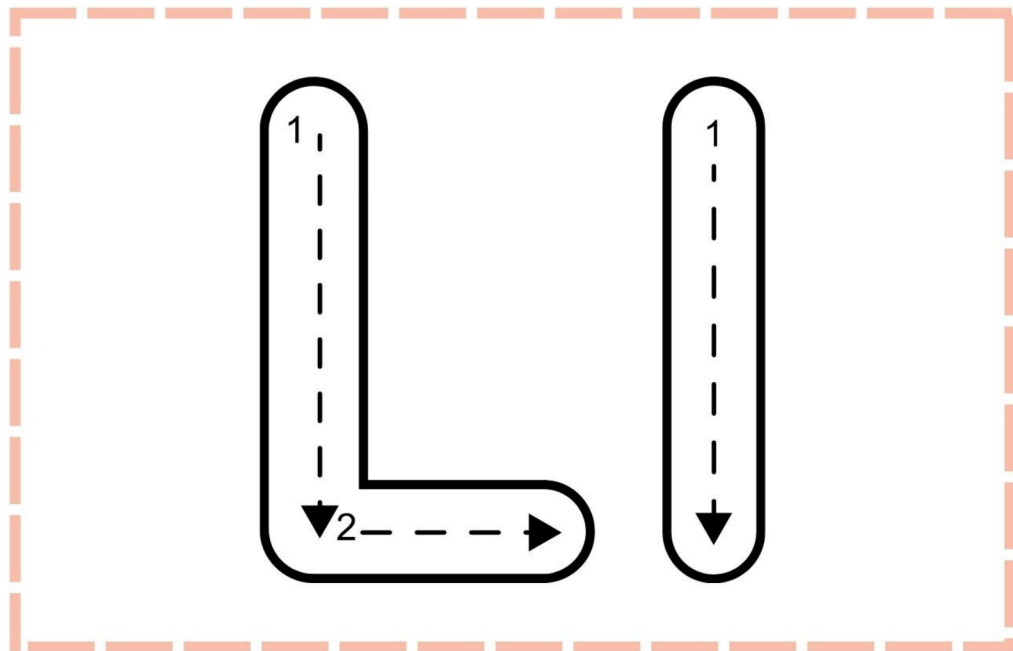
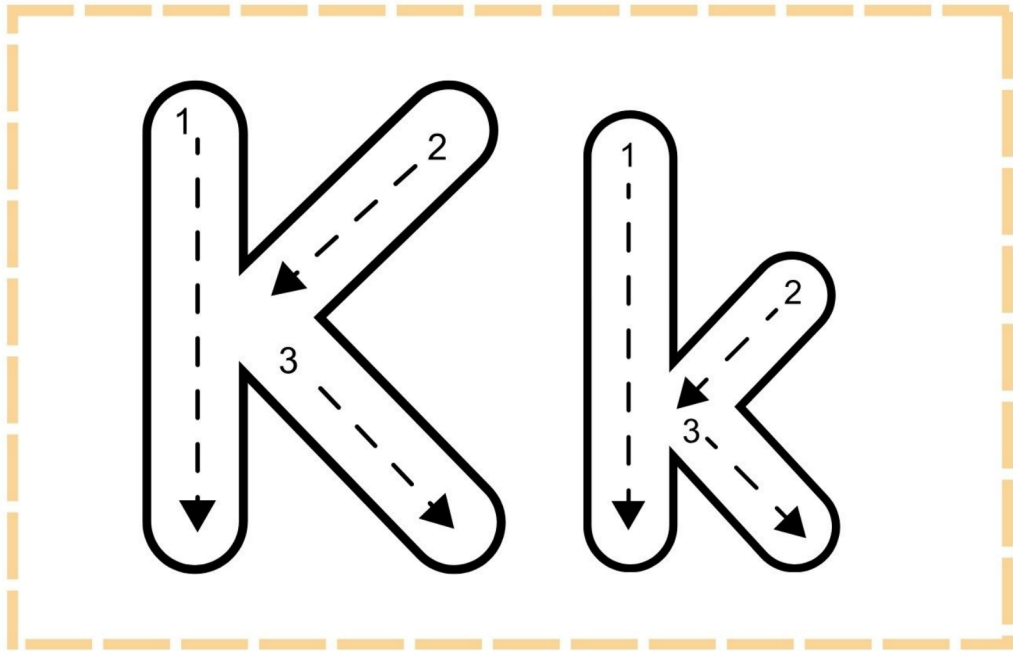


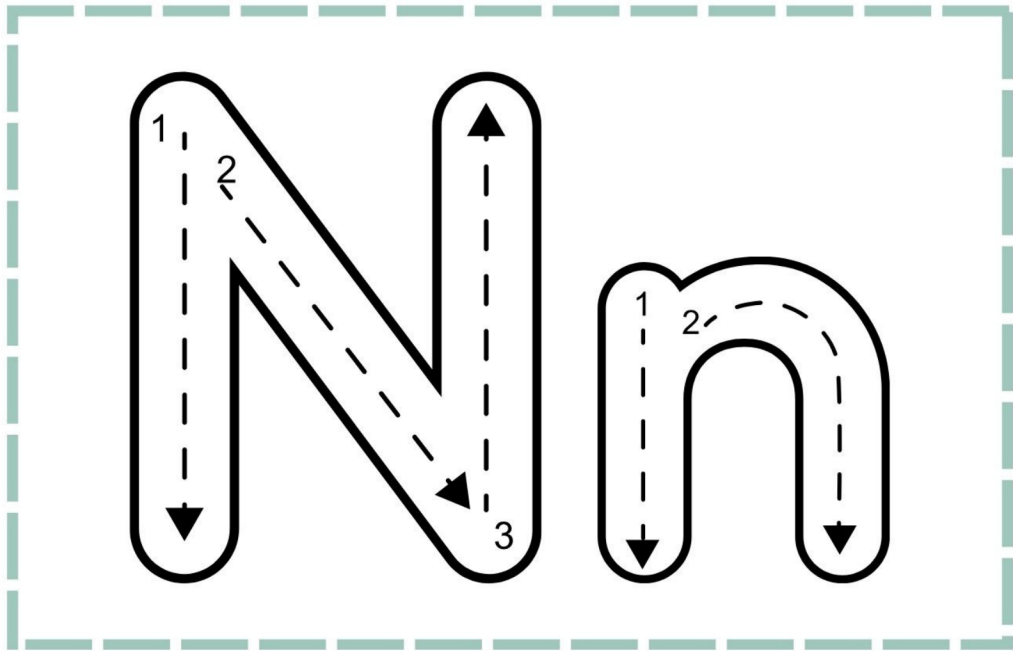
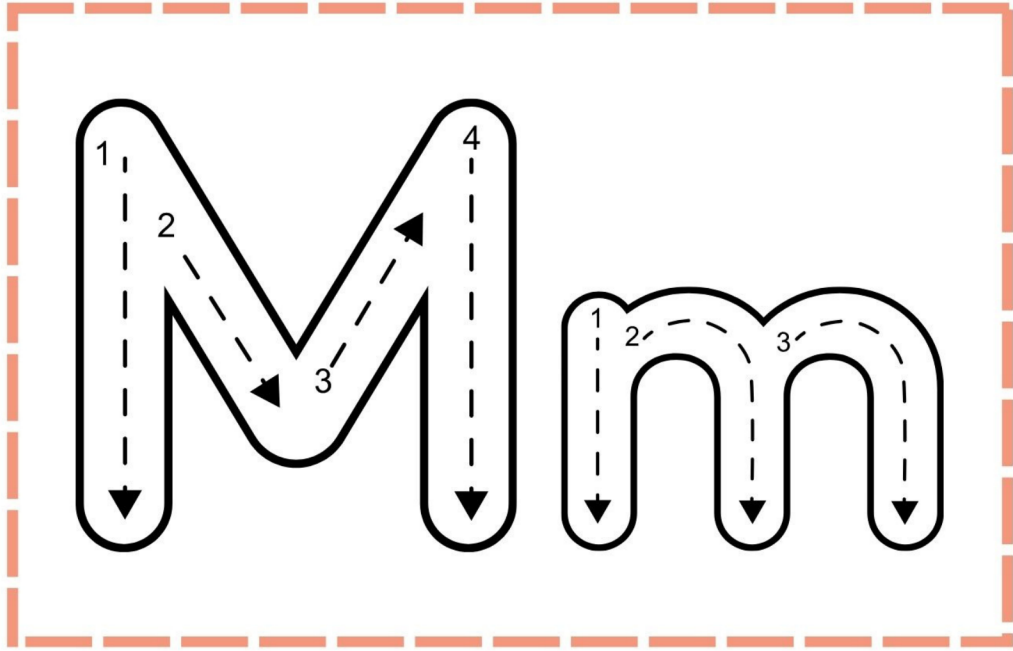


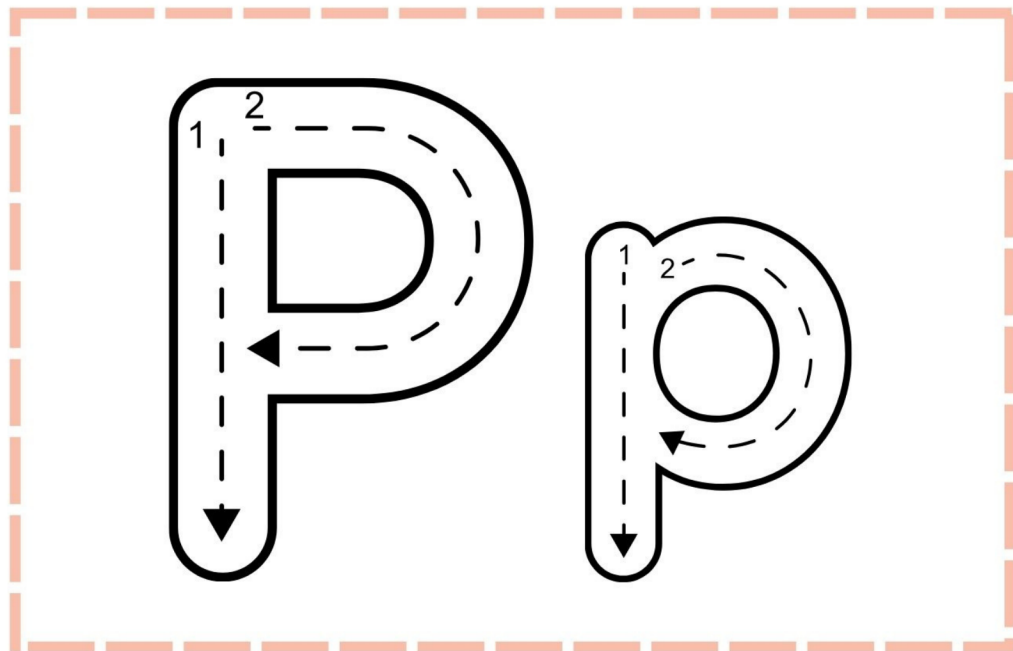
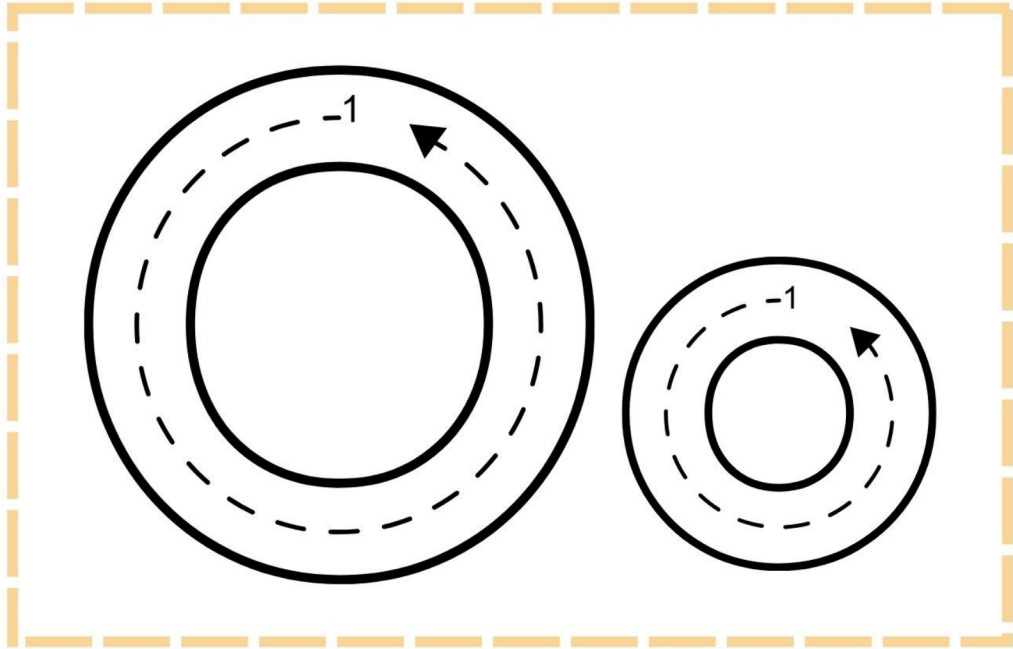


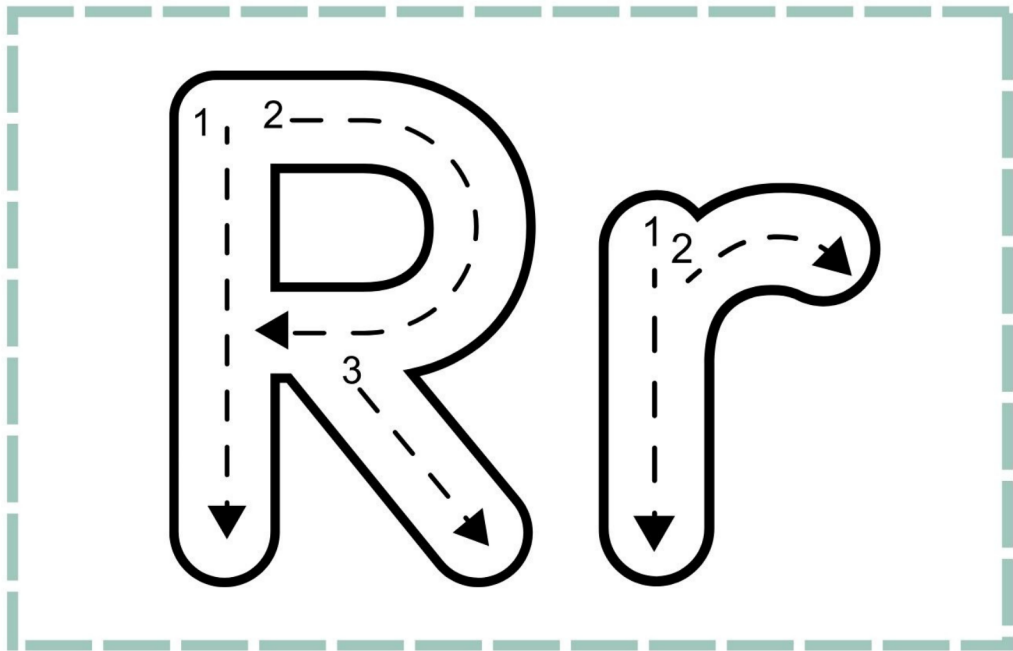
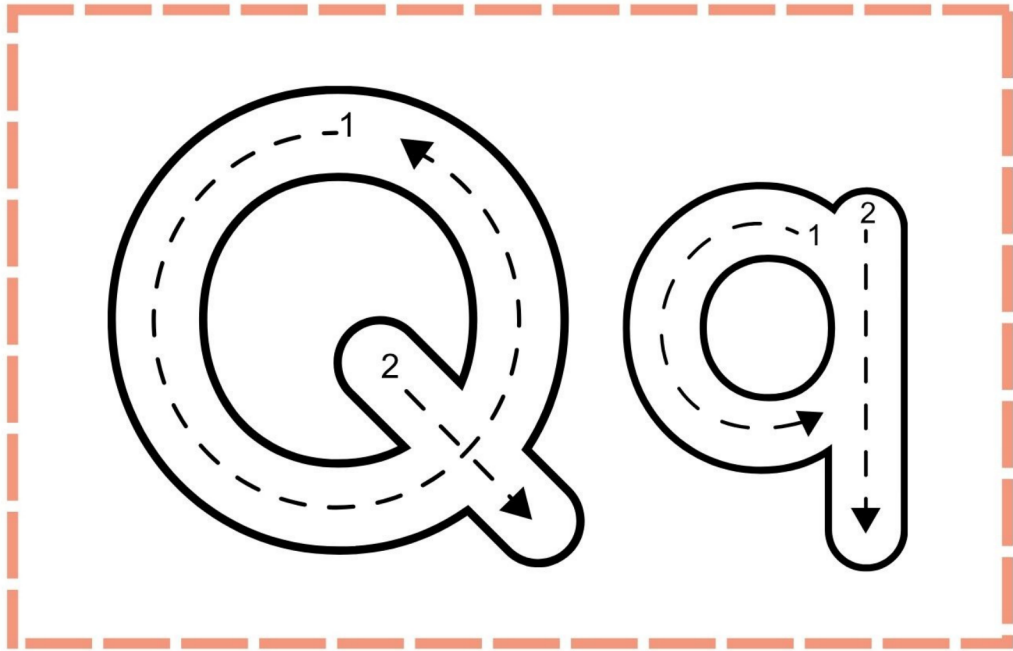


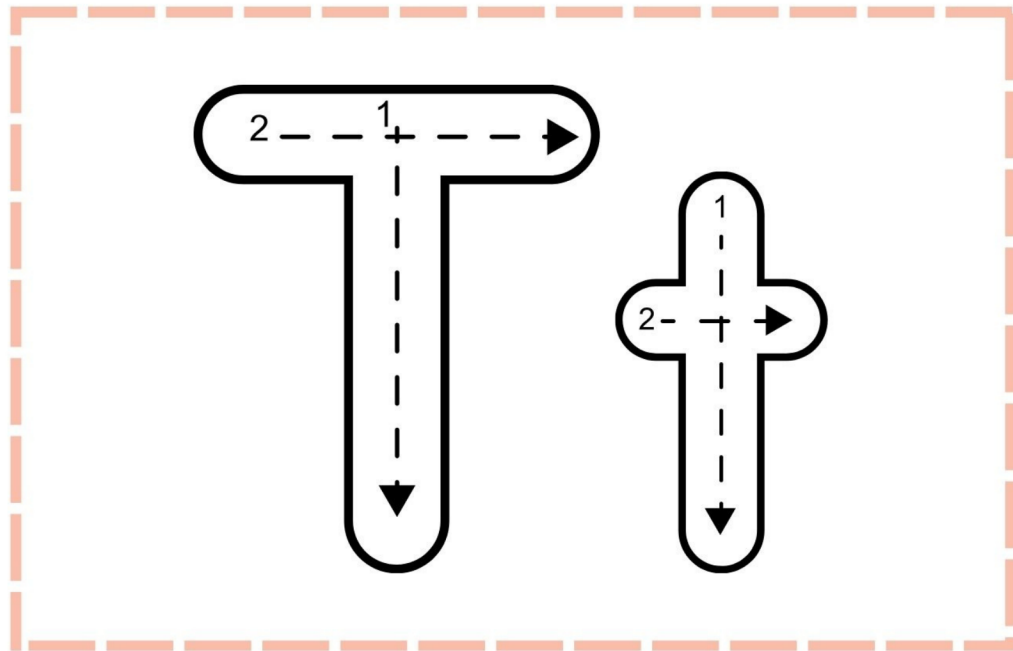


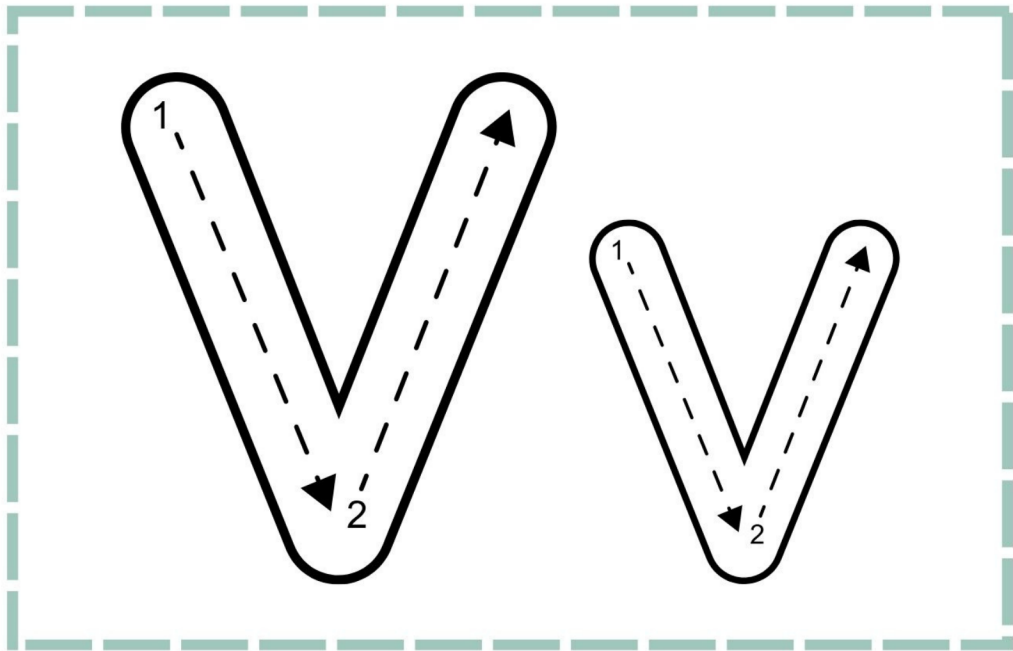
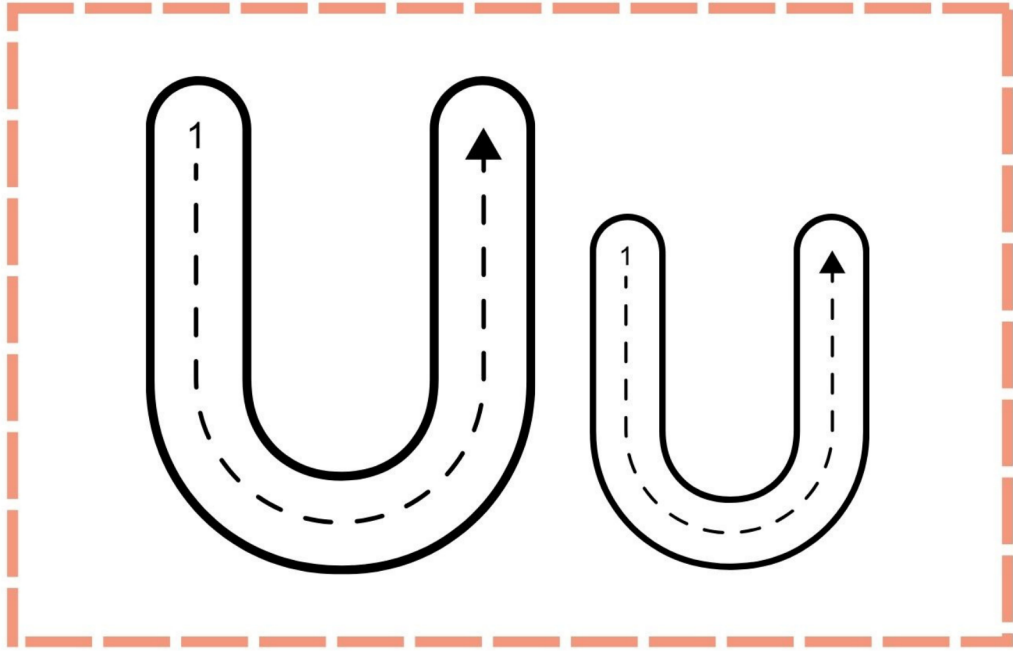


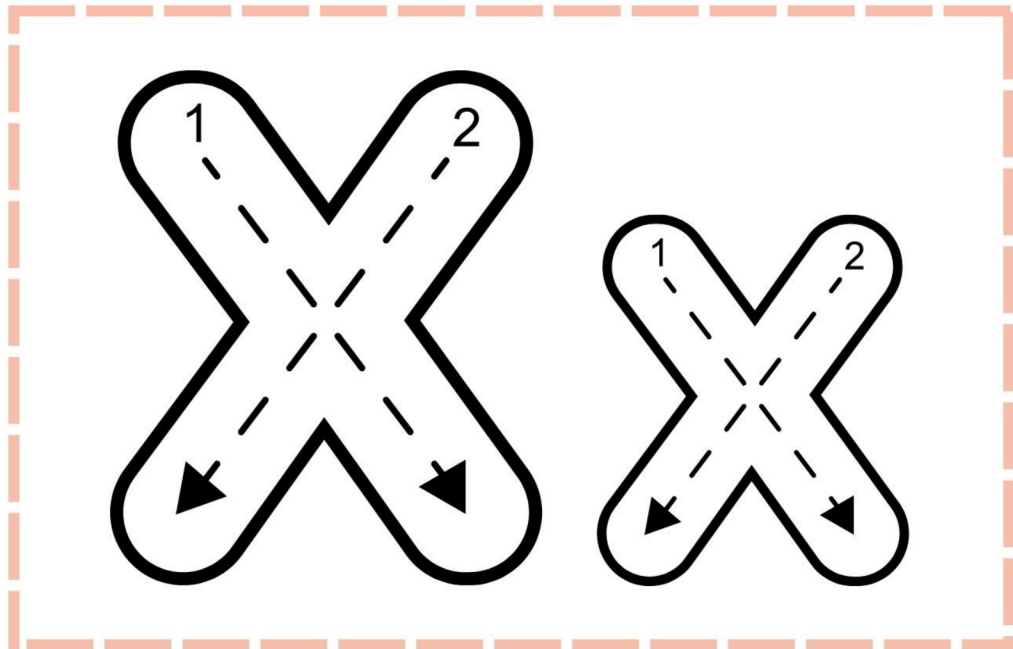


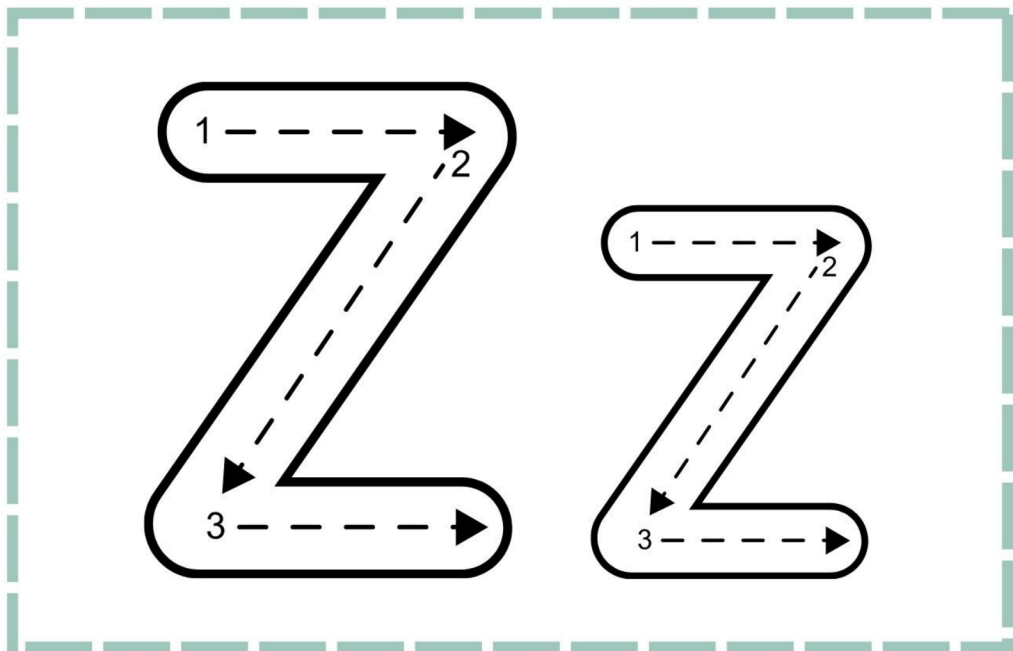
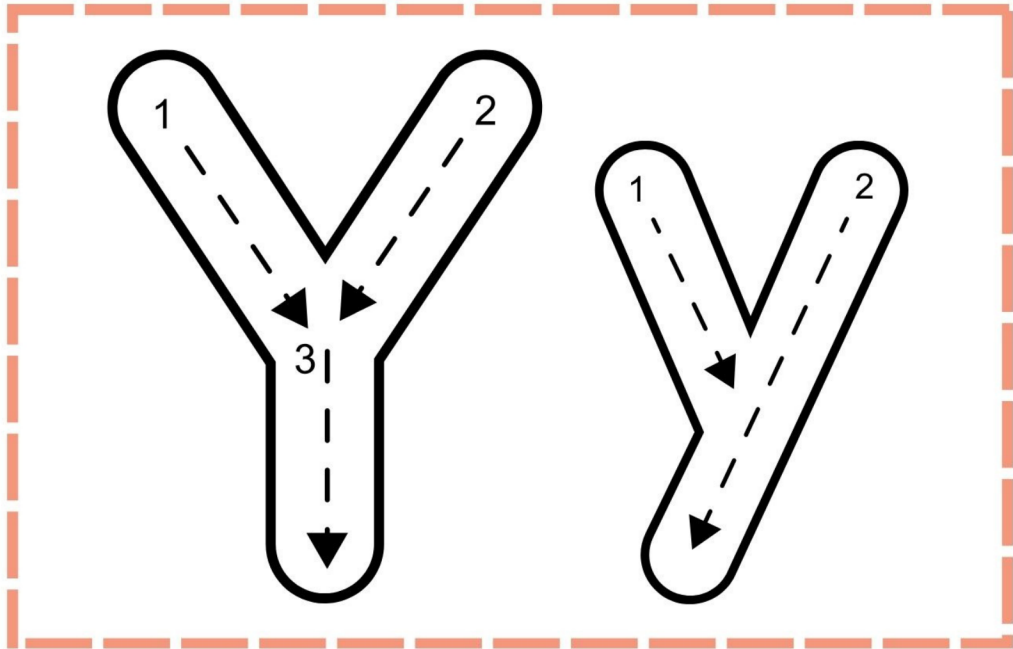












FIVE SENSES NATURE SCAVENGER HUNT

Smell the delicious aroma.

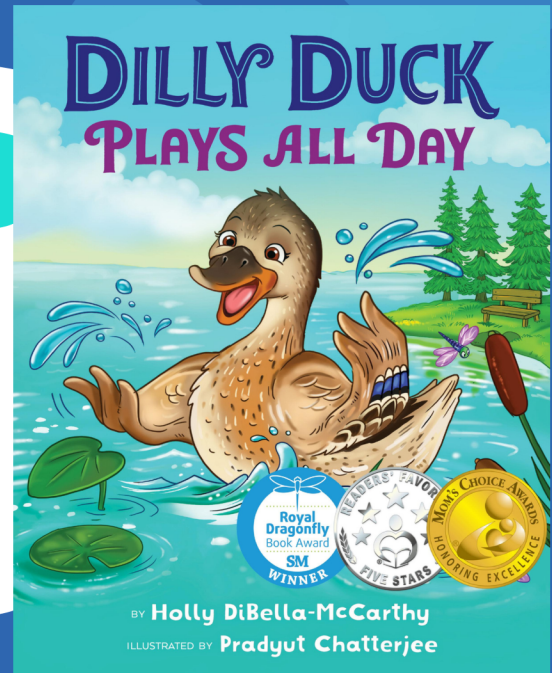
Feel the popcorn and fill a bowl.
