


Read each color word and color Dilly's Valentine the same.

I Can Draw Hearts


Help Billy Beaver trace or color the hearts.




Color Sorting Tic Tac Toe

All By Myself Recipe Berry Good Cone Snack

Ingredients:

sugar cones

fruit and berries

Options can include
berries, grapes,
banana, apple chunks,
child's favorite

melted chocolate

Tools:

colander

paper towels

small bowls







Steps:


- 1. Wash hands.
- 2. Gather ingredients and tools.
- 3. Wait for an adult to melt chocolate in microwave and it has cooled enough to touch.
- 4. Dip cone tops into chocolate and allow chocolate to dry
- 5. Gather fruit choices.
- 6. Wash fruit using a colander. Pat dry.
- 7. Cut banana into slices using a child-safe knife.
- 8. Sort fruit into bowls by type.
- 9. Fill cone with fruit choices.
- 10. Enjoy!

Adult Jobs: Help 'read' recipe. Allow the child to do as much as possible independently.

Melt 1 cup chocolate chips or chocolate melts in microwave- stopping every 15 seconds to stir and let cool to touch, Encourage your child to name each fruit and the fruit color as they prepare!
