



All By Myself Recipe for: Apple Donuts

Ingredients:

apple slices



water-lemon juice mixture

peanut butter



cocoa

toppings: rainbow sprinkles, mini chocolate chips, granola, mini-marshmallows, chopped nuts or seeds



Tools:

mini cookie cutter



cutting board or mat

spoon, safe knife

small bowls






plate



- 1. Wash hands.
- 2. Gather ingredients and tools.
- 3. Wait for an adult to cut apple into 1/2 inch rounds.
- 3. Use mini cookie cutter to remove the center of each. apple slice, or ask an adult to cut center out.
- 4. Soak apple slices in 1 cup water and 1 Tablespoon lemon juice mixture for 5-10 minutes. Pat dry.
- 5. Mix 1/4 cup peanut butter and 1/2 Tablespoon cocoa together. Spread on each apple slice.
- 6. Add toppings of your choice.
- 7. Place apple donuts on plate.
- 8. Enjoy!


