HIGH CONCEPT

When a patriotic American track star is paralyzed by an IRA bullet during the Bloody Sunday riots, her journey to recovery spans three continents and ignites a spiritual awakening that challenges everything she believes about faith, justice, and the human spirit.

SYNOPSIS

Angel, a devout Christian and Olympic hopeful, follows a divine calling that leads her from American college tracks to the volatile streets of Northern Ireland during the height of The Troubles. When she's shot and paralyzed while speaking at a Bloody Sunday demonstration, her unwavering faith is shattered.

Meanwhile, Bone, an African American musician studying to become a human rights lawyer, dreams of fighting apartheid in South Africa. Angel's paralysis is reversed through inexplicable stem cell regeneration.

Set against the backdrop of global political upheaval—from IRA terrorism to South African apartheid—the novel weaves together the lives of unlikely characters: a patriotic American athlete, a socially conscious musician, an IRA Captain and his two sons (one a devoted terrorist-in-training, the other a physics prodigy with a chip on his shoulder). Their stories converge in unexpected ways, challenging notions of faith, patriotism, and redemption.

As Angel recovers and returns to competitive athletics, she must reconcile her renewed physical abilities with her spiritual journey, ultimately leading her to Olympic gold and a deeper understanding of divine purpose.
