# Prater Fire & Rescue Receives New Turnout Gear & Helmets Through MSA and DuPont's Globe Gear Giveaway

With this new gear, our firefighters will be better equipped to handle a wide range of emergencies, from structural fires to hazardous material incidents. The improved protection and functionality will enhance

both the safety and efficiency of our personnel, underscoring our dedication to providing the highest level of service to the Prater area and surrounding communities.

"Our volunteers selflessly devote their time to protect our community," said Chief Jeff Fuller. "They deserve well-made and compliant gear that will help keep them safe as they respond to dangerous incidents. While a lack of funding has made it difficult to maintain this goal, MSA and DuPont's Globe Gear Giveaway with the NVFC made it possible."

Too many volunteer fire departments are familiar with having to make do with an inadequate amount of turnouts or with worn-out, non-compliant gear they can't afford to replace. Looking to change that, MSA and DuPont with the NVFC partnered in 2012 to provide free turnout gear to volunteer fire departments across the U.S. and Canada each year. To date, 663 sets of gear have been donated to 147 departments.

Helmets were added to the giveaway in 2019 when MSA found that 50 percent of program recipients did not have enough for their members. Since the program began, over \$1 million worth of gear has been provided to enhance the protection of volunteer firefighters.
