241108701 - On 11/27/2024, Deputies responded to the area of Highway 46E / Highway 41 and took a report of a silt sock auger attachment theft. The skid steer attachment is owned by J&M Land Restoration and used for erosion control, was custom built, and valued at \$15,000. The attached photograph is the original version of the attachment but the pipe on the side of the attachment had been changed to 6". There were no specific markings or serial numbers on the attachment and only the attachment was taken.

241208747 - On 12/2/2024, Deputies responded to the same general area of Highway 46E / Highway 41 and took a PC 487 report from Papich Construction. The theft occurred sometime between 11/22/2024 – 12/02/2024. Taken was heavy equipment keys, truck keys, grading laser levels, and miscellaneous tools from the work trucks. Attached is a stock photograph to a Top Con Laser valued at \$6,200 (SN JB7889). Additionally, multiple Milwaukee tools were taken including a M18 Rotary Hammer (SN L85BD230201669). The stolen property has been entered into APS.
