





Circa 1724, John Wesley graduated & the following year, became a deacon. Inside Christ Church Cathedral, John's Priest ordination for 'The Church of England' commenced in 1728. On May 24th, 1738, he started reading the Bible. Verses discussed God's promises. These Scriptures enlightened Wesley and these words highlighted the closeness of God's Heavenly Kingdom. It begins when John attends a church service inside St. Paul's Cathedral. He then comprehends spiritually about what is persuading this individual conviction. An anthem impressed upon the man, "Out of the depths have I cried unto thee, O Lord!" Psalm 130:1 - KJV.

REASSURANCE
