



# Senpai Cosplay Cruise Non-Participant Policy 2019

Due to the agreement we have with Norwegian Cruise Line, and in an effort to be fair to all of our paid participants, it is our policy at Senpai Cosplay Cruises that you **MUST** be a paid group member to participate in our events on the upcoming Norwegian Bliss event.

## **What does this policy mean?**

Well, it means that, to join us in our SCC-exclusive activities, all participants must have booked their passage on the Bliss through our official travel agent, and paid our group rated cruise fare. There are no exceptions.

## **Why does this policy exist?**

The SCC 2019 event works because we all participate as a group. We are being given discounted cruise fare, and discounted or free amenities based upon our financial participation. We have agreed not to sell or market our activities to others on the ship during the cruise. Additionally, NCL has their own legal and contractual obligations as awarded to us by our group agreement. These become compromised if we include non-participating cruisers in our events and may become a legal issue.

## **What are the limitations of the policy?**

There is nothing restricting the access of SCC 2019 participants and regular cruise ship attendees from having fun together in public areas of the ship or during public NCL activities and events. If you meet someone on the cruise (or before the cruise in a group or chat), you are absolutely allowed to hang out with them, and vice versa, in public-access areas and during public-access events.

## **What events are non-SCC 2019 participants not allowed do with us?**

Cruisers who are not part of the SCC 2019 Event can not participate in the following: scheduled group photoshoots, group restaurant reservations, the Welcome Reception, the movie night (aka Slumber Party), exclusive excursions, breakout sessions, scavenger hunt, Farewell Dinner, and any other SCC 2019 exclusive event not included in this list.

## **What else does this policy affect?**

Non-SCC 2019 participants are not eligible to receive any free or discounted physical items which we have received permission to distribute during the event. Some of these

items may be available to purchase in advance of the event or after the close of the event, if requested. These items include, but are not limited to: T-Shirts, pins or buttons, stickers, Shark OFF promotional jewelry, goodie bags, food, drink, and any other item not specified in this list.

Because the Senpai Cosplay Cruise 2019 Event was intentionally limited to a small number of people, we do not expect that everyone in the cosplay community “heard” about us and so, we fully acknowledge that there are cosplayers who are finding out about us after the close of the participation deadline. We still want to be as inclusive as possible and foster budding friendships as they are discovered on The Bliss, but we can not break our legal and contractual obligations with Norwegian Cruise Lines.
