### What Are You Transferring in Your Life?

**Key Scripture: "A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children, but the wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous."**

(Proverbs 13:22 NKJV)

**Every day we are transferring something to others.**

We transfer words.

We transfer attitudes.

We transfer habits.

We transfer knowledge.

We transfer faith.

We transfer love.

**The question is not whether you are transferring something.**

**The question is: What are you transferring?**

Long after our money is spent, our possessions are gone, and our names are forgotten by many, the things we transferred into the hearts and lives of others often remain.

Our lives are like rivers. Whatever is flowing through us eventually flows into someone else.

### **Point 1: Are You Transferring Faith or Fear?**

**2 Timothy 1:5 (NKJV)** *"When I call to remembrance the genuine faith that is in you, which dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice..."*

Paul recognized that Timothy's faith did not begin with Timothy.

Faith had been transferred.

**His grandmother invested in his mother.  
His mother invested in him.**

**Three generations were connected through faith.**

Fear spreads quickly.  
But faith can spread even faster.

**Ask yourself:**

- What do my children see when life gets difficult?
- Do people see me trust God?
- Am I transferring confidence in Jesus or confidence in myself?

**Point 2: Are You Transferring Blessings or Bitterness?**

**Hebrews 12:15 (NKJV)** *"Looking carefully lest anyone fall short of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up cause trouble..."*

Bitterness rarely stays contained.

It transfers.

A bitter heart can influence a family.  
A bitter attitude can affect a church.  
A bitter spirit can impact friendships.

Likewise, kindness transfers.  
Grace transfers.  
Forgiveness transfers.

People often drink from the well we have dug.

**Make sure the water is clean.**

**Point 3: Are You Transferring Truth or Confusion?**

**Deuteronomy 6:6-7 (NKJV)** *"And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children..."*

God never intended biblical truth to stop with one generation.

Truth must be transferred.

Parents transfer it.

Teachers transfer it.

Pastors transfer it.

Believers transfer it.

We live in a world filled with confusion, but God's Word provides clarity.

***Every conversation is an opportunity to transfer biblical truth.***

#### **Point 4: Are You Transferring the Love of Christ?**

**John 13:35 (NKJV)** *"By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."*

People may forget your sermons.

They may forget your accomplishments.

But they rarely forget how you made them feel.

The love of Christ should overflow from our lives.

Transfer encouragement.

Transfer compassion.

Transfer patience.

Transfer mercy.

The world has enough criticism.

**What it desperately needs is believers who transfer the love of Jesus.**

## Point 5: What Legacy Are You Transferring?

**Psalm 145:4 (NKJV)** *"One generation shall praise Your works to another, and shall declare Your mighty acts."*

Every generation is handing something to the next generation.

What will we hand them?

### Will we transfer:

- A love for God's Word?
- A passion for prayer?
- A commitment to holiness?
- A desire to serve others?
- A heart for evangelism?

*Or will we leave them spiritually empty?*

### Practical Questions

Ask yourself:

1. What am I transferring through my words?
2. What am I transferring through my actions?
3. What am I transferring through my attitude?
4. What am I transferring into my family?
5. What am I transferring into the Kingdom of God?

### Conclusion

One day our lives on earth will be finished.

The houses, vehicles, possessions, and bank accounts will remain behind.

But what we transferred into others will continue.

May we transfer faith instead of fear.

Hope instead of despair.

Truth instead of confusion.

Love instead of bitterness.

Jesus instead of ourselves.

Because every day we are making deposits into someone's life.

The question remains:

**What are you transferring?**

Guided prayer: Heavenly Father, thank You for the people You have placed in our lives. Help us become faithful stewards of the influence You have given us. Let us transfer faith, hope, truth, wisdom, and the love of Jesus to everyone around us. May our lives point others toward You and leave a legacy that honors Your name.
