Remember this:

2. **Love is a choice, not just a feeling** – Biblical love is sacrificial, patient, and kind (1 Corinthians 13).
3. **Forgiveness fuels longevity** – Holding grudges will break a marriage. Grace and mercy keep it whole.

Questions

1. **Q: Why is God's presence important in a marriage?**
A: Because He brings unity, peace, and spiritual direction. A cord of three is not easily broken (Ecclesiastes 4:12).
2. **Q: What is the husband's biblical role?**
A: To lead with love, sacrifice, and protection—just as Christ loves the church (Ephesians 5:25).

3. **Q: How can couples handle conflict biblically?**

A: By being quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to anger (James 1:19), and always ready to forgive.

1. **Put God first** – Together, seek Him daily in prayer and the Word.
2. **Pray together often** – Inviting God into your marriage strengthens your bond.
3. **Forgive quickly and often** – Don't let bitterness take root.
4. **Speak life over one another** – Use your words to build, not break.
5. **Honor and respect each other** – As image bearers of Christ.
6. **Be humble and willing to grow** – Marriage reveals areas where growth is needed.
7. **Keep your covenant holy** – Guard your hearts, your minds, and your home.
8. **Serve one another daily** – Love in action creates lasting intimacy.
9. **Stay rooted in the Word** – Scripture will be your compass during hard times.
10. **Celebrate your love often** – Make time for fun, laughter, and joy!

Create a fun Bible trivia challenge at home (or play online), and see who remembers more Bible facts! Loser cooks dinner or gives the winner a foot massage. 😊
