Jesus Appearing to 2 Disciples on The Road to Emmaus.

Story found in Luke 24:13-35

Jesus appeared to two disciples as they walked from Jerusalem to a village called Emmaus, about seven miles away.

Luke 24:13–14 – Two disciples are walking to Emmaus, talking about everything that happened.

Luke 24:15–16 – Jesus Himself walks up and joins them, but their eyes are restrained from recognizing Him.

Luke 24:17–27 – Jesus explains the Scriptures to them, showing how the Law and the Prophets all pointed to Him.

Luke 24:30–31 – When He breaks bread with them, their eyes are opened and they recognize Him.

Luke 24:32 – They say, "Did not our heart burn within us... while He opened the Scriptures to us?"

Luke 24:33–35 – They immediately return to Jerusalem to tell the others that He is risen.
