

20 Questions All Christians Need to Ask Themselves

I wanted to create this list to encourage believers to pause, reflect, and take an honest look at their walk with Jesus. Sometimes life gets busy, hearts get distracted, and we need a simple reminder to check where we are spiritually. This list is not meant to bring guilt or pressure, but to help us grow, draw closer to God, and stay rooted in His truth. My prayer is that it helps Christians examine their hearts, strengthen their faith, and keep living ready, faithful, and full of love for the Lord.

Check-Off List

- Am I spending time with God in prayer every day?
- Am I reading the Bible and letting God's Word guide my life?
- Am I truly putting Jesus first in my daily choices?
- Is my life reflecting the love of Christ to others?
- Am I quick to forgive, or am I holding onto offense?
- Am I trusting God, even when I do not understand what He is doing?
- Are my thoughts pleasing to the Lord?
- Are my words building others up or tearing them down?
- Am I living in obedience to what God has already shown me?
- Am I allowing fear, worry, or doubt to control me more than faith?
- Am I walking in humility before God and others?
- Am I showing kindness, patience, and grace to the people around me?
- Is there anything in my life I need to repent of and give fully to God?

- Am I using the gifts God gave me to serve Him and bless others?
- Am I growing spiritually, or have I become spiritually lazy?
- Am I surrounding myself with Godly influence and wisdom?
- Am I being a light for Jesus in my home, work, and community?
- Do I have a heart that is thankful, even in hard seasons?
- Am I sharing the Gospel and pointing people to Jesus?
- If Jesus came back today, would I be living ready?

A check-off list like this is not about being perfect. It is about being honest before God, letting the Holy Spirit search our hearts, and growing stronger in our walk with Jesus one faithful step at a time.

Examining our hearts is important because it helps us slow down, be honest before God, and see where we are in our walk with Him. It gives us time to reflect, repent where needed, grow stronger in faith, and draw closer to Jesus. I am so glad you are taking the time to do this check-off list and reflect, because a heart that is willing to be examined by God is a heart that is being shaped, strengthened, and prepared for all He wants to do in your life.
