Size & Space Requirements

“Do I actually have enough space for a plunge pool?”

The good news is, most backyards can accommodate one, but understanding size and space requirements early can save time, money, and frustration later.

A plunge pool is designed for compact living, but the pool itself is only part of the equation. You'll also need space for surrounding paving, pool fencing, and safe access areas. As a general guide, allow at least 1–1.5 metres around the pool for compliance, maintenance access, and comfortable use.

setbacks from boundaries, buildings, and easements. Access is equally important, many pools need to be delivered into position via a crane however, Pure Plunge pools can be hand delivered via a side access or over a fence in some cases. Planning for delivery early helps avoid unexpected installation costs or delays.

plunge pools balance length, width, and depth with how you plan to use the space. A well-proportioned pool can make a small yard feel larger while still providing room for seating, landscaping, and entertaining areas.
