

Resolution Censuring Senator Lindsey Graham for Abandoning the GOP Platform by Participating in The Russia Collusion Hoax with Senator John McCain and Provoking World War III with Russia

Whereas the national Republican Party Platform states in promise #8 that we will “PREVENT WORLD WAR THREE, RESTORE PEACE IN EUROPE AND IN THE MIDDLE EAST, AND BUILD A GREAT IRON DOME MISSILE DEFENSE SHIELD OVER OUR ENTIRE COUNTRY – ALL MADE IN AMERICA”;

Whereas on May 6th, 2016, a few months after dropping out of the presidential race, Senator Graham said, “I also cannot in good conscience support Donald Trump because I do not believe he is a reliable Republican conservative, nor has he displayed the judgement and temperament to serve as Commander in Chief... I do not plan to attend the Republican convention in Cleveland this summer.”;¹

Whereas on December 9, 2016, after neither Senator McCain nor Senator Graham endorsed President Trump in the presidential election, Senator McCain followed Senator Graham’s suggestion that Senator McCain personally hand the Steele dossier to FBI Director James Comey;²

Whereas on December 31, 2016, Senator Graham and Senator McCain visited Ukrainian marines in Ukraine to provoke them into fighting Russia;³

Whereas Senator Graham confirmed that he trusted the Steele dossier when he said on January 1, 2017, while in Ukraine that “...we hope to make 2017 a year of offense. We believe that Putin has hacked into our elections in America. That he’s trying to undermine democracy all over the world.”;⁴

Whereas Senator Graham was accompanying Senator McCain on January 1, 2017, and Senator McCain further confirmed that he trusted the Steel dossier when he said, “...we will be working for much tougher sanctions against Russia. They attacked the United States of America. The hacking was an attack, and it should be treated as such. And we think their financial institutions and other aspects of the Russia economy should be addressed and we will strongly urge our colleagues to enact more meaningful and stronger sanctions against Russia because of their attack on the United States of America”;⁵

Whereas on June 11, 2017, Senator Graham suggested that President Trump could be brought down because of his “inappropriate” statements about the investigation in the Russian-collusion hoax when Senator Graham said, “Now what the president did was inappropriate but here’s what’s frustrating for

Republicans like me. You may be the first president in history to go down because you can't stop inappropriately talking about an investigation that if you just were quiet, would clear you.”;⁶

Whereas on May 22, 2018, Senator McCain acknowledged in his book *The Restless Wave* that he knew the anti-Trump dossier contained “unproven accusations,” “mostly raw, unverified intelligence,” and allegations about which the senator “had no idea” if “any were true.”;⁷

Whereas on March 25, 2019, Senator Graham told President Trump that the late Senator McCain “deserves better” after President Trump on March 16, 2019, tweeted (quoting former Clinton-era independent counsel Ken Starr) “Spreading the fake and totally discredited Dossier ‘is unfortunately a very dark stain against John McCain.’”;^{8,9}

Whereas on March 4, 2022, Senator Graham called on someone in Russian Vladimir Putin’s inner circle to assassinate Putin while tweeting to the person who might assassinate Putin “you would be doing your country - and the world - a great service.”^{10,11}

Whereas on May 19, 2022, when the U.S. federal debt had reached \$30.6 trillion under President Joe Biden, Senator Graham unconstitutionally voted to pass H.R. 7691, to provide \$40.1 billion in fiscal year 2022 “emergency supplemental appropriations for activities to respond to Russia’s invasion of Ukraine.”^{12,13}

Whereas on February 14, 2025, Senator Graham said to Ukraine President Volodymyr Zelensky, “I want to tell you and your people, you’re the ally I’ve been hoping for all my life. You’ve taken our weapons, and you’ve kicked their ass. I’m proud to have you as our ally.”¹⁴

Whereas Senator Graham’s rejection of promise #8 of the national Republican Party Platform has damaged the reputation of the party, of America, and has nearly provoked World War III.

Therefore, be it resolved that the South Carolina 5th Congressional District Executive Committee:

1. Reaffirms its support for promising to prevent World War III.
2. Repudiates the actions of Senator Graham as a betrayal of Republican values.
3. Encourages the SCGOP to censure Senator Lindsey Graham; and
4. Orders that a copy of this resolution be sent to the SCGOP and to the Washington D.C. office of Senator Graham.
