



The award was presented on Harman's 95th birthday in recognition of

his service during World War I in France, where he was wounded in action. He is a widower with five children and 14 grandchildren. Harman, a native of DuBois, joined the U.S. Army at 17 and served in France during World War I. He was wounded and spent time in six hospitals, including four field hospitals. He became a dairy farmer and later a painter after his return.

Thank you for the information on the Pontius Family that you sent to the Lycoming County Historical Society. The Society passed it along to the Genealogical Society and we will place it in our library.

I wish I could give you some help on the Harman family. I believe that there are several different families by that name that settled in our area. I find them under Harman/Harmon/Herman. We have a book in our library about the Jacob Harman family - I see no relationship to your family. I have been researching an Amos and Henry Harman family for a lady in Florida. Again it appears that there is no relationship.

I copied the grantor and grantee deed indexes for Harman. Perhaps they will be helpful. Since I saw that an Eli H. Harman bough land in Montgomery, I checked the Montgomery Cemetery:
