It is especially beneficial for pets recovering from injury, managing chronic conditions, anxiety or immune challenges, facing mobility limitations, or showing behaviour changes related to physical or emotional stress.

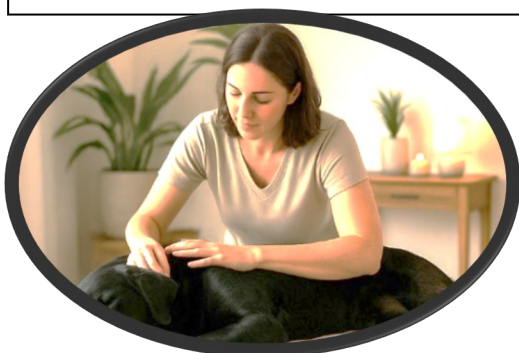
