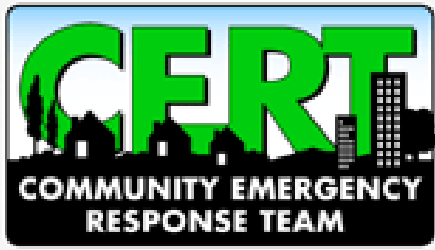

April 8, 2024 will be a total eclipse. Burnet County is expecting about 50,000 people. The EMC is in charge of safety & planning for that event is already occurring.

He discussed Evacuee Tracking Network for individuals who are evacuated.

He explained that the State Guard's mission is sheltering, and will try to set up sheltering training this summer.

CAPCOG, received \$24,000 for CERT. We will need to request any needed materials from them. CERT is considered a VOAD, Voluntary Organization Active in Disasters. We are not a 501(3)(c) and do not meet requirements for community grants from businesses. Will look into a 501(3)(c) later, but priority one is planning for the eclipse.
