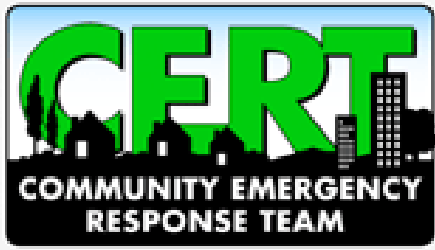

James Reimer, Vice Chair:

The dailytrilb.com is good resource for situational awareness like information on the Llano fire now, rabies awareness since there are three active cases currently, and an announcement of CPR training.

Robyn Ritcher, Training Officer:

Vaughn Hamilton will do training on Narcan and heat related problems tonight. She will schedule "Stop the Bleed" in small classes at the end of August/early September - probably a Saturday class in Marble Falls and a Thursday night class in Burnet. Each will be approximately two hours.

The new CERT class will begin the first Thursday in October. She will have an email put out to request help.

The Marble Falls EMS does monthly CPR classes which are free if you don't need the card.

Derek Marchio, Emergency Management Coordinator (EMC):

For the second quarter (April 1 to June 30, 2023) CERT members worked 202 hours – 116 for the general meeting, and the rest were for the Officers' meeting and the BOPATE event.

We had an active severe weather season in the spring – rains were near normal but still in drought. There was a great increase in severe thunderstorm weather and warnings from last year. The second wet season should begin at the end of August. We are seeing above normal temperatures and expect above normal heat through the rest of summer. It is expected that El Niño will bring more rain and cooler temperatures.

No general meeting is expected in October due to the new CERT class.
