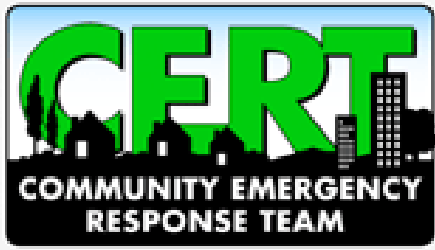

Publicity for upcoming CERT class:

Mary Jane Shanes announced that on September 20, 2022, Mr. Barho and Mr. Mark Ingram would be on "Coffee and Conversation at 8 am at the Foundation Building,

Flyers about the upcoming CERT class had been distributed widely including on the Burnetchamber.org website, both newspapers, all area chambers of commerce, mailed to the largest three churches, posted at the post offices, Ace Hardware, AgriLife, Community Resource Center, realtor's groups and Burnet Community Info website.

Mr. Barho advised that the second quarter citizen volunteer hours log was completed early on August 11, 2022; the FMAC balances were the same as last meeting, and Burnet County has had many fires but they were quickly handled by fire responders. There has also been some flooding but no reported damage s or deaths so no CERT call outs.

Twenty two people are registered for the upcoming CERT training. The class room can handle 30 comfortably. There is usually about a 20 per cent loss so 24 students works well. The applications have been reviewed and background checks conducted.
