Important Check-In Information & Tournament Guidelines

- Wristbands: All players must wear a tournament-issued wristband for the entire event, and one for each team they are rostered on. Lost wristbands will not be replaced.
- **Team Responsibility:** Team representatives/coaches are responsible for ensuring each rostered player has checked in, received, and is wearing their official wristband
- **Check-In:** Players must properly check in to receive a wristband.
- **Proof of Age and Identity:** Players must always have valid proof of age and identity available during the tournament. Acceptable forms include **USASA outdoor league player pass** or other photo identification such as a **driver's license, passport, or similar**.
- Matching Information: The name and date of birth on the ID must match the team's official roster exactly.
- **Proof of Registration:** Players must provide proof of registration with a **USASA-affiliated outdoor league** OR purchase a **3-Day Tournament Pass** for **\$11** to receive a wristband. SoktoberFest is a USASA sanctioned tournament.
- Roster Management: Only the designated HEAD COACH can add or remove players from the roster. The maximum roster size is 25 players.
- Roster Changes: Roster changes can still be made at the check-in tent before your team's first game.
- Roster Verification: The HEAD COACH is responsible for verifying the roster before the first game.
- Frozen Roster: All rosters are frozen once the team's first game kicks off. No exceptions.

Check-In & Tent Advisory

- We highly recommend checking in on Friday night, if possible, as Saturday morning tends to be very busy.
- Expect delays Saturday morning if players are not listed on the roster or do not have their player passes.

No-Show Penalty

In the case of a **no-show**, the absent team and all rostered players will be declared ineligible to participate in the following year's tournament **unless a \$250 penalty is paid in full**.

- This penalty must be paid directly to SoktoberFest before registration will be accepted for the following year.
- No rostered player from the no-show team will be eligible to participate until the penalty is satisfied.

Cheating or Illegal Players

Teams found **cheating** or using **illegal players** (including players without the correct wristband or playing on the wrong team) will **forfeit the match** and be disqualified from the tournament. The team and all rostered players will also be **ineligible to participate in the following year's tournament.**
