



New Team Guidelines

Welcome to NEOASA! The information below outlines the requirements and procedures for entering and managing a new team in the league.

Team Registration & Roster

- Teams may have a maximum of 25 registered players.
- Each team may register one Manager at the discounted fee of \$40.00. The Manager must select both Manager and Player during registration.
- All players must register online through GotSport at www.neoasa.org.
- Players must be 18 years or older.
- Managers may register players under their account using the Family Account option if needed.
- Payment must be received before the player is added to the official roster.
- Managers must email info@neoasa.org with the team name and requested division to have the team added.
- All players must register under the Open Age level.

New Team Performance Bond

- A \$100 New Team Performance Bond is required.
- The bond is refundable when the team leaves the league, provided there are no outstanding referee fees.
- The bond may be used to cover referee fees if a team fails to field enough players or fails to cancel a game at least 48 hours in advance.
- Teams are responsible for all referee fees in these situations.
- Outstanding referee fees must be paid before the team is allowed to play again.

Referee Fees & Game Day Requirements

- Referee fees must be paid in cash at check-in prior to each game, along with the official Match Card printed from GotSport.
- Men's Open (3 referees): \$85 per team per game
- Women's and Coed (1 referee): \$35 per team per game
- Masters (7v7): \$20 per team per game
- Managers are encouraged to collect referee fees from players in advance.
- Managers must submit the Match Card and referee fees to the center referee prior to each game.

Divisions Offered

- Men's A, B, and C (11v11)
- Men's Over 40 (11v11)
- Men's Masters Over 45 (7v7)
- Women's Divisions 1 and 2 (11v11)
- Women's Masters (7v7) – Spring & Fall: Over 40 / Summer: Over 35
- Coed Division (11v11 – Friday nights)
- Summer League: Multiple Open, Over 30, and Coed divisions available (All 7v7)

Game Schedule

- Sunday games between 1:00 PM and 7:00 PM
- Additional Wednesday or Thursday games may be scheduled if needed
- Masters games are played Thursday evenings (7v7 format)
- Each season consists of at least 8 games
- Coed 11v11 divisions consist of 6 games
- Division winners receive championship shirts
- Mid-season registration may be available at a discounted rate

Field & Facility Rules

- No practices or scrimmages allowed at the Torchia-Oliver SoccerPlex
- No glass containers allowed

- No pets allowed
