

"Lord, Teach Us to Pray...": Prayer Practices to Nourish Men: An Online Workshop for Men" with Fr. Brad Karelius, on Saturday, August 29, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon, on the Zoom platform. This online workshop will explore ways of praying that can feed the spiritual hunger that the men of today experience. Prayer has the power to transform our inner spirit and how we experience God in the movement of everyday life. Sustaining a daily life of prayer that does not demand of us energy we cannot muster, includes familiar and repetitious ritual that is clearly defined and time limited. With this in mind, we will learn about and experience three forms of structured prayer in order to foster a discipline of daily prayer: *The Examen of Consciousness*: a daily practice of gratitude and discernment of God's movement in our lives; *Centering Prayer*: practicing the presence of God and listening for God's inspiration as to how we might live our lives; *The Daily Office/Breviary*: as a way of praying throughout the day and reflecting upon the word of God. UPCOMING: Online Workshop

Center for Religion and Spirituality at Loyola Marymount University: Free Online Webinar Series for First Responders, "Armor Up, Armor Down: The Inner Life of Cops, Firefighters and Medics," Thursdays, October 8, 15, 22, and 29

The greatest psychological and spiritual challenge to First Responders (police officers, firefighters, and medics) is losing heart for a role they once saw as a great adventure and means of serving society. Recently, many police officers, firefighters, and medics have expressed high levels of frustration amid the social unrest, the pandemic and political divisions. Some are doubting their choice to do this work. This is unfortunate. Their initial instincts were sound. Dedicating one's self to the adventure of serving and helping others on the frontlines of danger, crisis and acute need has always been a noble and worthy calling. It still is. But the intrinsic rewards are not a given nor are they automatic and may be more difficult to realize during these times. These four 90-minute webinars take a different approach to First Responder wellbeing. Rather than focus on breakdown, we present an introduction to the inner life of First Responders – their thoughts, feelings, beliefs, concerns, values and character – and how these are impacted by the role, identity and work. We move beyond the problem-oriented approaches to reframe the role and work as a spiritual path, where adversity is an expectation and experiences are leveraged into personal development, growth, insight, maturity and depth. The sessions are designed to provide insight, guidance and tools to First Responders and those working with them in the roles of peer support, counselor, psychologist, chaplain and leadership. While these sessions are focused on First Responders, they are open to the public. The sessions are free. They will be held as follows:

All on Thursdays, from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

October 8: "Much More Than a Job or Career"

October 15: "Working on the Friendship with Yourself"

October 22: "Rocking with Adversity"

October 29: "Rediscovering and Cultivating Calm"
