### **ARTICLE III: MEMBERSHIP**

- A. The Association prohibits discrimination in any manner against any applicant or member because of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin as provided in applicable state and federal law.
- B. Membership shall be open to any person who endorses the purpose of this organization and pays the annual membership fee and abides by the By-Laws of this organization.
- C. A membership fee is due and payable January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. Any member who shall fail to pay their indebtedness will be declared terminated and forfeit all privileges until such dues are remitted to the treasurer.
- D. The Board of Directors may, over a period of time, have to re-establish the membership fees.
- E. Each membership in good standing is entitled to one vote.
- F. A membership can be revoked by a simple majority vote of the members present at a general membership meeting.
- G. Members may be accepted from out of state. They may vote, but are not eligible to be a Director or an Officer.
