CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

- A – (2) 3" x 3" squares
- B – (4) 2" x 3 ½" rectangles

Fabric 2:

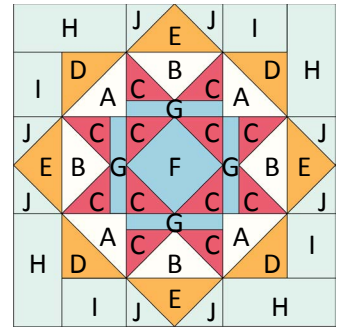
- C – (12) 2" x 2" squares

Fabric 3:

- D – (2) 3" x 3" squares
- E – (4) 2" x 3 ½" rectangles

Fabric 4:

- F – (1) 3 ½" x 3 ½" square
- G – (4) 1" x 3 ½" rectangles



Fabric 5:

- H – (4) 2" x 4" rectangles
- I – (4) 2" x 2 ½" rectangles
- J – (8) 2" x 2" squares

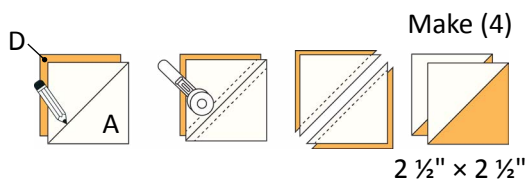
FG = FLYING GEESSE

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

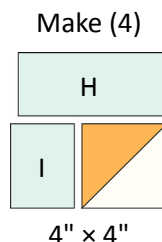
Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

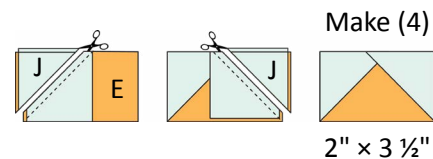
- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) A-squares, (12) C-squares, and (8) J-squares.
- Place (1) marked A-square on (1) D-square, RST. Sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut along the drawn diagonal line and press to make (2) HST units. Trim each unit to measure 2 ½" x 2 ½". Repeat to make (4) total units.



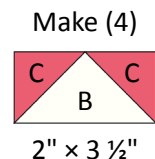
- Sew (1) I-rectangle to the left side of (1) HST unit. Next, add (1) H-rectangle to the top to make (1) Corner Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.



- Align (1) marked J-square with top left corner of (1) E-rectangle, RST. Sew on the drawn diagonal line. Trim excess corner fabric to ¼". Press toward the corner. Next, align (1) marked J-square with top right corner of the same E-rectangle, RST. Sew, trim, and press as before to make (1) E/J FG unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.



- Repeat Step 4 using marked C-squares and B-rectangles to make (4) total B/C FG units.



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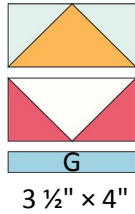

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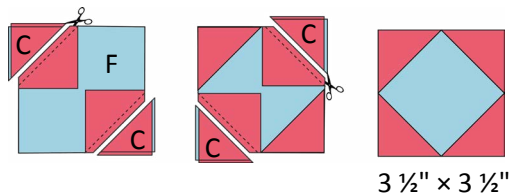
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6. Sew (1) E/J FG unit, (1) B/C FG unit, and (1) **G**-rectangle to make (1) Side Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.

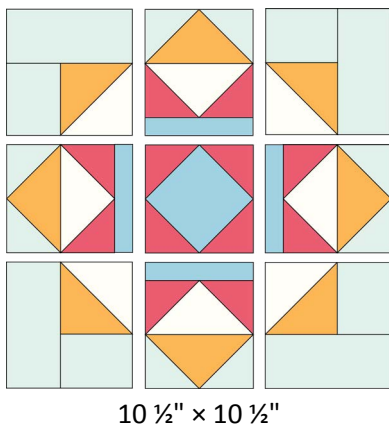

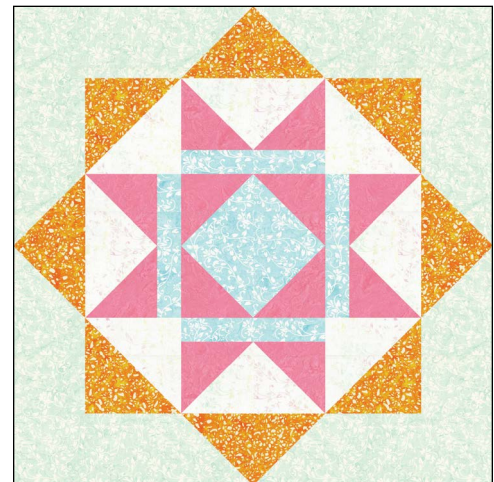
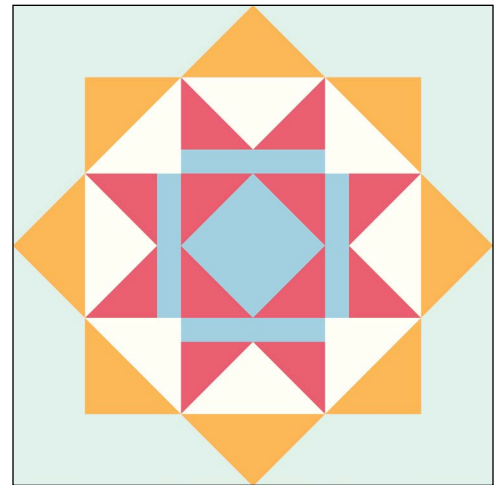
7. Align (2) marked **C**-squares on opposite corners of (1) **F**-square, RST. Sew on the drawn diagonal lines. Trim excess corner fabric to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press toward the corners. Next, align (2) marked **C**-squares on the remaining opposite corners of the same **F**-square, RST. Sew, trim, and press as before to make (1) Center Unit.



8. Arrange (4) Corner Units, (4) Side Units, and (1) Center Unit as shown below. Sew the units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make Block 9. Block 9 should measure $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
