RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER SNF = STITCH AND FLIP FG = FLYING GEESE Sew all seams RST and with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS Fabric 1:

- A (1) 3 ½" × 3 ½" square
- B (4) 2 ¾" × 2 ¾" squares, cut in half diagonally once*
- C − (4) 2" × 3 ½" rectangles
- D − (8) 2" × 2" squares

Fabric 2:

- E − (4) 2 ½" × 3 ½" rectangles
- F (4) 2 1/4" × 2 1/4" squares
- G (8) 2" × 2" squares


Fabric 3:

• H – (2) 4 ½" × 4 ½" squares, cut in half diagonally once


*Note: B has been slightly oversized for EASE of assembly. If you prefer to use a scant seam allowance, the original cutting found in the Cutting Guide is usable.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) **D**–squares and (8) **G**–squares.
- Sew (1) B-triangle to the right side of (1) F-square as shown below. Next, add (1) B-triangle to the bottom. Use the ¼" Plus Ruler to trim ¼" outside the F-square along the diagonal edge. Repeat to make (4) total units.




 Sew (1) H-triangle to (1) Step 2 unit as shown below to make (1) Corner Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units. Trim each unit to measure 4" x 4".



Align (1) marked **D**—square with the top left corner of

 (1) **E**—rectangle, RST. Sew on the drawn diagonal line. Trim excess corner fabric to ¼". Press toward the corner. Next, align
 (1) marked **D**—square with the top right corner of the same E—rectangle, RST. Sew, trim, and press as before to make
 (1) SNF unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.



Repeat Step 4 using marked G-squares and C-rectangles to make (4) total FG units.



6. Sew (1) SNF unit to the top of (1) FG unit to make (1) Side Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.


10" × 10" Finished



7. Arrange (4) Corner Units, (4) Side Units, and (1) **A**–square as shown below. Sew the units and square together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make Block 10. Block 10 should measure 10 ½" × 10 ½" unfinished.
