

• $E - (1) 6" \times 6"$ square

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 3:

- F − (4) 1 ½" × 2 ¾" rectangles
- G (8) 1 ½" × 1 ½" squares



RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

SNF = STITCH AND FLIP

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.





SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) **B**-squares and (8) **G**-squares. Draw a diagonal line in both directions on the wrong side of (1) **A**-square.
- Align (2) marked B—squares on opposite corners of

 (1) E—square, RST. Sew on the drawn diagonal lines. Trim excess corner fabric to ¼". Press toward the corners. Next, align
 (2) marked B—squares on remaining opposite corners of the same E—square, RST. Sew, trim, and press as before to make
 (1) Center Unit.







3. Use the SNF method from Step 2 to add (1) **G**–square to each corner of (1) Center Unit.




 Use the SNF method from Step 2 to add (1) G-square to the bottom right corner of (1) C-square to make (1) Corner Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.




Place (1) marked A-square on (1) D-square, RST. Sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal lines. Cut along the drawn diagonal lines and through the vertical and horizontal center. Press to make (8) HST units. Trim each unit to 2 ¾" × 2 ¾".




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
6. Sew (2) HST units and (1) **F**-rectangle together to make (1) Side Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.




7. Arrange (4) Corner Units, (4) Side Units, and (1) Center Unit as shown below. Sew the units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make Block 16. Block 16 should measure 10 ½" × 10 ½" unfinished.
