#### **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Fabric 1:

- A (4) 3" squares
- B (4) 3" × 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

#### Fabric 2:


• C – (8) 3" squares

#### Fabric 3:

- D (4) 3" squares
- E − (2) 3 ½" squares

#### Fabric 4:

• F – (2) 3 ½" squares




#### **SEWING INSTRUCTIONS**

**HST** = HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE, **SNF** = STITCH AND FLIP

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) C squares,
   D squares, and (2) E squares.
- Place (4) C squares onto bottom left corners of (4) B – rectangles, right sides together. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines. Trim excess corner fabric to ¼". Press toward the corners.
- 3. Repeat SNF technique to attach (4) D squares onto bottom right corners of the same B rectangles to make (4) Flying Geese units measuring 3" × 5 ½" unfinished.




Place (2) E – squares with (2) F – squares, right sides together. Sew a ¼" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal lines. Cut along the drawn diagonal lines, making (4) E/F HST units. Trim HST units to measure 3" × 3" unfinished.




5. Place (4) C – squares with (4) E/F HST units, right sides together. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines. Trim excess corner fabric to ¼". Press toward the corners to make (4) SNF units. The SNF units should measure 3" × 3" unfinished.



6. Arrange (4) SNF units as shown. Sew the units together in pairs. Press in direction of arrows. Then sew the pairs together and press to complete block center. The block center should measure 5 ½" × 5 ½" unfinished.



7. Arrange (4) A – squares (4) Flying Geese units, and block center as shown. Sew the pieces together in rows and press. Then sew the rows together and press to complete Block 3. Block 3 should measure 10 ½" × 10 ½" unfinished.
