CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

• (10) 3" × WOF strips. Set (6) aside (A). From remaining (4) strips, subcut:

(16) 3" × 10 ½" rectangles (B)

• (2) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(4) 2 ½" × 6 ½" rectangles (C)

(9) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares (D)

Fabric 2:

• (4) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares (E)

Fabric 3:

(8) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares (F)

Fabric 4:

 (13) 3" × WOF strips. Piece (7) together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 3" × 65 ½" strips (G)

(2) 3" × 60 ½" strips (H)

From remaining (6) strips, subcut:

(2) $3" \times 40 \%"$ strips (I)

(2) $3'' \times 35 \%''$ strips (J)

(2) 3" × 15 ½" strips (K)

(2) $3" \times 10 \%"$ strips (L)

Fabric 5:

(6) 3" × WOF strips (M)

Fabric 6:

(7) 2 ½" × WOF strips for binding

WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC

RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

SNF = STITCH AND FLIP

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) F-squares.
- Align (1) marked F-square with the bottom left corner of
 (1) C-rectangle, RST. Sew on the drawn diagonal line. Trim
 excess corner fabric to ¼". Press toward the corner. Next, align
 (1) marked F-square with bottom right corner of the same
 C-rectangle, RST. Sew, trim, and press as before to make
 (1) Side Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.






 Arrange (5) D-squares and (4) E-squares as shown below. Sew the pieces together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Center Unit.



 Arrange (4) D-squares, (4) Side Units, and (1) Center Unit as shown below. Sew the pieces together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Star Unit.









 K-rectangle to the top and bottom to make (1) Center Star Unit.





6. Sew (2) **A**–strips and (2) **M**–strips together. Press to make (1) strip set. Repeat to make (3) total strip sets. Cut the strip sets into (40) 3"-wide segments.




7. Sew (14) Step 6 segments together as shown below, rotating every other segment 180° to form a checkerboard pattern.

Repeat to make (2) total units.




8. Sew (6) Step 6 segments together as shown below, rotating every other segment 180° to form a checkerboard pattern.

Repeat to make (2) total units.



- 9. Sew (1) Step 8 unit to each side of the Center Star Unit. Next, add (1) Step 7 unit to the top and bottom.
- 10. Sew (1) **J**-strip to each side of the Step 9 unit. Next, add (1) **I**-strip to the top and bottom to make the Quilt Center.



11. Arrange Blocks 1-16 and (16) **B**—rectangles into rows as shown below. Sew the blocks and pieces into rows.







- 12. Sew the Left Side Block Row and the Right Side Block Row to each side of the Quilt Center. Next, add the Top Block Row and Bottom Block Row to the top and bottom.
- 13. Sew (1) **H**-strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Next, add (1) **G**-strip to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.



FINISH THE QUILT

14. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.

Your quilt is complete!
