CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

- A – (4) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 6" rectangles
- B – (4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles

Fabric 2:

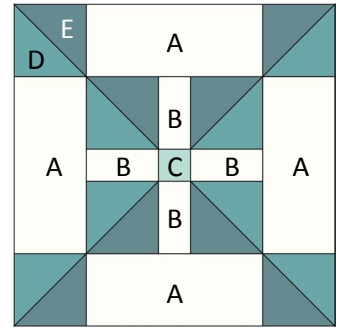
- C – (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square

Fabric 3:

- D – (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square

Fabric 4:

- E – (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square

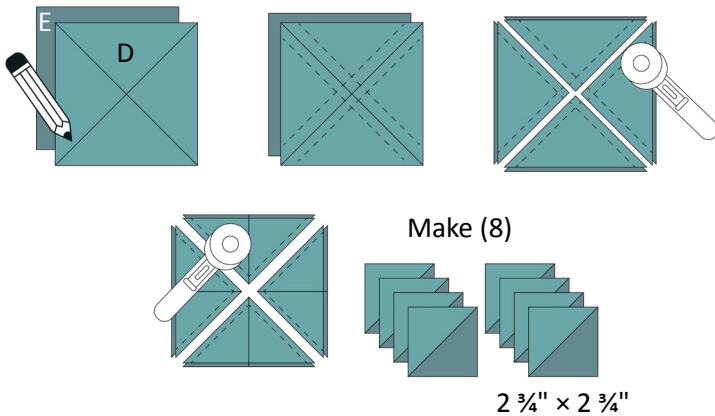
RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

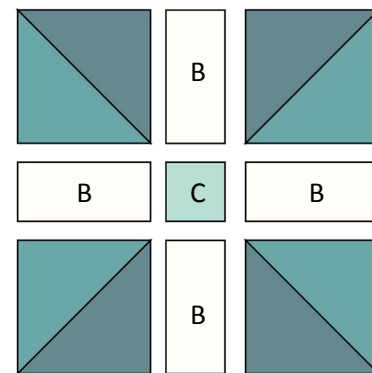
Sew all seams RST and with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Draw a diagonal line in both directions on the wrong side of (1) **D**-square.
2. Place (1) marked **D**-square on (1) **E**-square, RST. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the drawn diagonal lines. Cut along the drawn diagonal lines and through the vertical and horizontal center. Press to make (8) HST units. Trim each unit to measure $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ ".



3. Arrange (4) HST units, (4) **B**-rectangles, and (1) **C**-square as shown below. (Pay attention to the orientation of the HST units.) Sew the units and pieces together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make the Center Unit.

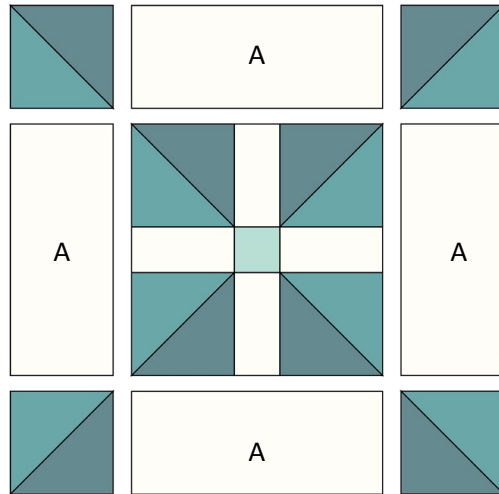
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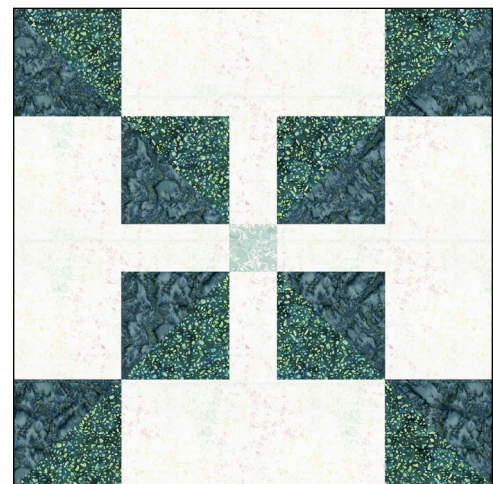
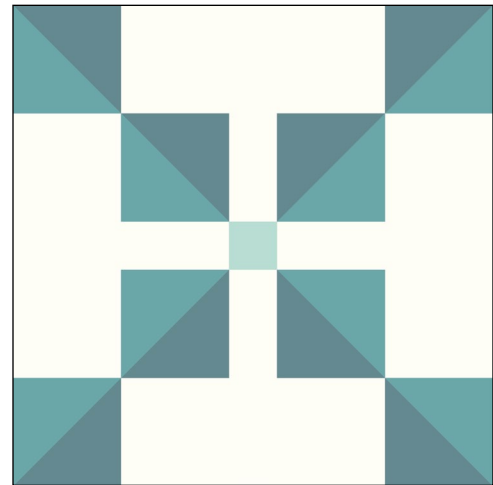
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4. Arrange (4) HST units, (4) **A**-rectangles, and (1) Center Unit as shown below. (Pay attention to the orientation of the HST units.) Sew the rectangles and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make Block 4. Block 4 should measure 10 ½" × 10 ½" unfinished.
