## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

### Fabric 1:

- A – (1) 6" x 6" square
- B – (4) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares
- C – (1) 1 ½" x 20" strip
- D – (1) 1 ½" x 12" strip
- E – (4) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles

### Fabric 2:

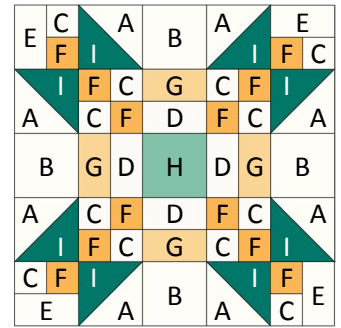
- F – (1) 1 ½" x 20" strip

### Fabric 3:

- G – (1) 1 ½" x 12" strip

### Fabric 4:

- H – (1) 2 ½" x 2 ½" square



### Fabric 5:

- I – (1) 6" x 6" square

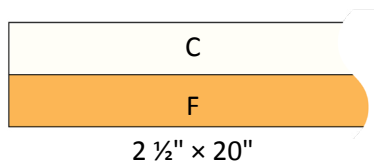
RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

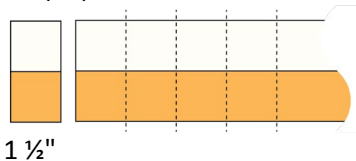
Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Draw a diagonal line in both directions on the wrong side of (1) **A**-square.
2. Sew (1) **C**-strip and (1) **F**-strip together. Press to make (1) strip set. Cut the strip set into (12) 1 ½"-wide C/F segments.

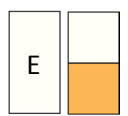

3. Sew (1) **E**-rectangle to the left side of (1) C/F segment. Repeat to make (4) total units.

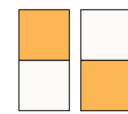

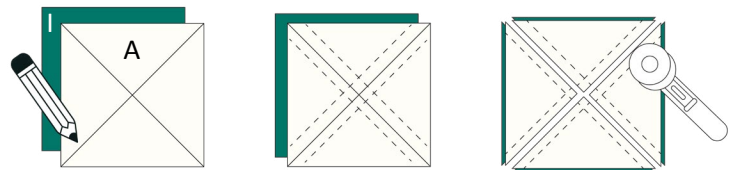
4. Sew (2) C/F segments together to make (1) Four-Patch unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.

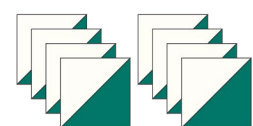
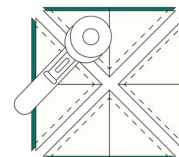

5. Place (1) marked **A**-square on (1) **I**-square, RST. Sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal lines. Cut along the drawn diagonal lines and through the vertical and horizontal center. Press to make (8) HST units. Trim each unit to measure 2 ½" x 2 ½".

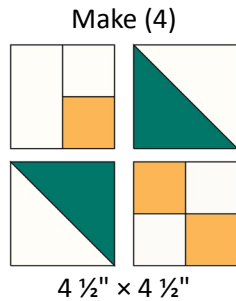

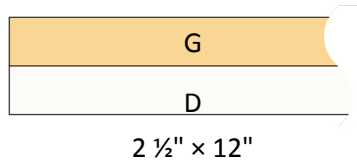

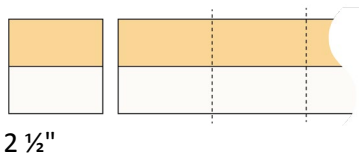
6. Arrange (1) Step 3 unit, (2) HST units, and (1) Four-Patch unit as shown below. (Pay attention to the orientation of the HST units.) Sew the units together in pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make the Corner Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.



7. Sew (1) **G**-strip and (1) **D**-strip together. Press to make (1) strip set. Cut the strip set into (4) 2 ½"-wide D/G segments.

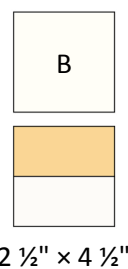

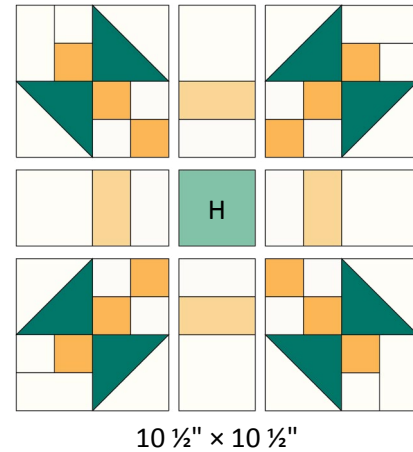


8. Sew (1) **B**-square to the top of (1) D/G segment to make (1) Side Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.

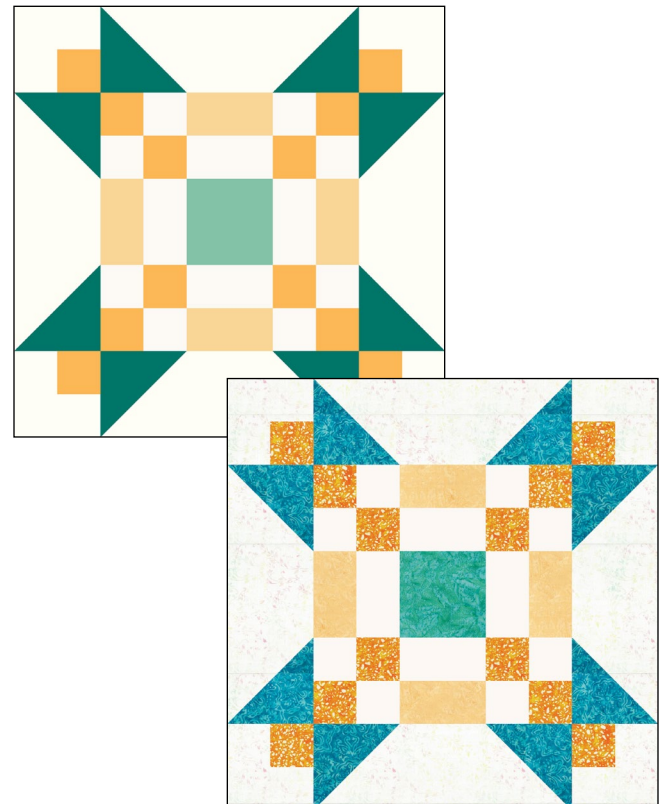

9. Arrange (4) Corner Units, (4) Side Units, and (1) **H**-square as shown below. Sew the units and square together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make Block 7. Block 7 should measure 10 ½" × 10 ½" unfinished.
