

NOTES ON GREENE COUNTY VOTERS SPREADSHEET JULY 15 2018

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1. Some numbers are approximate; one total off by 0.4% (see paragraph 11 below)
2. Row 4: ages 18+: percentage applied for Greene is from entire state; guess that Greene will be a little older
3. Party breakdowns are of registered "active" voters (I don't know what makes voters "active" vs "inactive")
4. Rows 13 vs 16: 9,504 presidential votes in county in 2016 vs 8,884 congressional (Dittmar or Garrett); no info on other congressional candidates; ignorance gap or enthusiasm gap? Can we improve on Dittmar's 2,577? Kaine running should help.
5. Rows 14-16; biggest ratio in favor of Garrett was in Stanardsville (3.4 to 1); smallest was in Midway (2.0 to 1) [might look at ratio of Republicans to Democrats vs vote ratio]
6. **Row 18: Note wide variation in numbers between precincts;** some precincts should have many more canvassers than others
7. Row 18 includes unknowns, but not "no data"
8. Row 30, "No Data" – there are lots of people! not broken down by precinct other than Swift Run (see next paragraph)
9. Line 30, "No Data" – I did construct list for Swift Run (my precinct) – 649 people, 466 doors! Should we engage these people? When and how?
10. (CORRECTED) column is from searches done county-wide; I screwed up by small amounts in a couple of places; just where, I didn't have the energy to find out.
11. Cell G-31, TOTAL WITH NO DATA, should equal cell G-18 ALL ACTIVE. But it's off by $11,189 / 11,145 = 1.0039$ i.e. 0.4%. A difference small enough I didn't want to go back thru all the searches, but anyone who wants to find out where I goofed, be my guest. 😊
