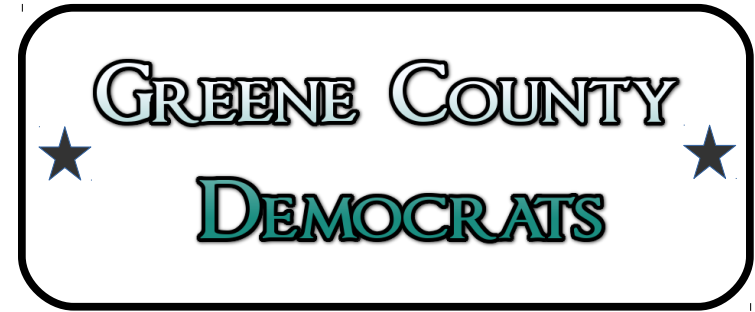

VOTING INFORMATION

Voter Registration Deadline for Nov 6, 2018 Election is Monday, Oct 15

If Not Registered To Vote:

For copies of Voter Registration Forms or Absentee Ballot Applications, go to www.vote.virginia.gov. You can call or visit the Greene County Registrar's office.

Voting By Absentee Ballot:

You may vote by Absentee Ballot if you have a permissible reason to do so, such as poor health or traveling out of town on Election Day. Absentee Ballot voting begins on Friday, September 21. The last day to Request an Absentee Ballot is Tuesday, October 30. You may vote by Absentee Ballot in person at the Registrar's Office or by mailing the ballot to P. O. Box 341, Stanardsville, VA, 22973. A mailed ballot must be received by Election Day. The Registrar's Office has special open hours for Absentee Ballot voting on Saturdays, Oct. 27th and Nov. 3rd. November 3, 2018 is the last day to vote by Absentee Ballot at the Registrar's Office.

If Registered To Vote:

Unfortunately, we all now know that we must guard our voter information very carefully. Before the election, check your registration information by going online or in person with the Registrar. Visit our web site: <https://democratsofgreencounty.com>, for help in checking your registration status.

Important Note: The Stanardsville Precinct polling place has been moved from the American Legion Hall to the Greene County Piedmont Virginia Community College (PVCC) in the Greene County Library Building, second floor entrance above the Library.
