NAVFAC (Naval Facilities Command) "Our expertise enables mission success." Systems Command that builds and maintains sustainable facilities, delivers utilities, and services, and provides Navy expeditionary combat force capabilities. With 13 component commands, civilians and contractors who serve as engineers, architects, contract specialist delivering the best in facilities engineering and acquisition for the Navy and Marine Corps, Unified Commanders and the Department of Defense agencies through capital improvements, environmental projects, expeditionary, public works and asset management.



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
NAVSEA (Naval Sea Systems Command) "We design, build, deliver and maintain ships and systems on time and on cost." Accountable for the health of the navy, they purposely operate to ensure the Navy can protect and defend America. NAVSEA is comprised of command staff, headquarters directorates, and Program Executive Offices (PEOs) and numerous field activities. They engineer, build, buy and maintain ships, submarines and combat systems that meet current and future operational requirements.

NSW (Naval Special Warfare Command) "To man, train, equip, deploy and sustain NSW forces for operations and activities abroad and in support of combatant commanders and U.S. national interests." The SEALs have been the maritime component of the U.S. Special Operations Command. In times of war or uncertainty there is a special breed of warrior ready to answer our Nation's call.

NETWARCOM (Naval Network Warfare Command) "Execute tactical-level and control to direct, operate, maintain and secure Navy communications and network systems for the DoD Information networks; leverage Joint Space capabilities for Navy and Joint Operations."
