

The Only Remedy for the Cancer of Sin

The dictionary definition of the word “**remedy**” is: *the application or treatment that cures and heals an affliction.*

Sometimes a remedy corrects or counteracts a condition, circumstance or a particular situation. The only remedy for the cancer of sin in the world today is the Gospel of Jesus Christ that was first preached in the year AD 33 of the first century.

All through the New Testament, we find the message Jesus taught the Apostles. According to the words of Jesus, this message had a beginning. (**Luke 24:45-47**) The beginning of the preaching of this message that Jesus gave the Apostles was at Jerusalem on the Day of Pentecost. (**Acts 2:37-39,41**)

In **Matthew 16:19**, Jesus gave Peter the Keys to the Kingdom of God. These keys were repentance, water baptism by immersion in the Name of Jesus Christ, and the infilling of the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in other tongues as the Spirit gives the utterance. (**John 7:38-39, Acts 1:5 2:1-4**)

Jesus said you must be born again. (**John 3:3,5,7**) The message of the Gospel has never changed. The Word of God is forever settled in Heaven. (**Psalms 119:89**) **Hebrews 13:8** says Jesus is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

We must all speak the same thing that Jesus and the Apostles taught. (**1 Corinthians 1:10**) Confusion occurs only after the original meaning of Scripture is altered. God is **NOT** the author of confusion. (**1 Corinthians 14:33**)

Jesus is the author and finisher of our faith. (**Hebrews 12:2**) To all those who choose to believe and obey, Jesus becomes the Author of Eternal Salvation. (**Hebrews 5:9**) Jesus abolished death, the death that sin brings. Jesus brought life and immortality to light through the Gospel of Jesus Christ. (**2 Timothy 1:10**)

Many things are being taught and believed today that are simply wrong. These things contradict the Word of God. You cannot believe in something that you know nothing about.

Faith cometh by hearing and hearing by book, chapter, and verse from the Word of God. (**Romans 10:17**) The Word of God will come from someone who has been sent from God into your life. (**Romans 10:15**)

There are thousands of people today that say God has called them to preach, yet what they preach is in error to what is written in the Scriptures. In the world of religion, there are many voices speaking, but there is only one voice that we must heed which is the voice of His Word. **(Psalms 103:20)**

John 10:4-5 tells us that His sheep know His voice and a stranger they will not follow but would flee from the voice of a stranger. Many times, when people hear things preached over and over in their church, they assume that it is correct.

They never examine to see whether what is being said is true or not. The Scripture tells us to prove all things. **(1 Thessalonians 5:21)** Doctrine means the things that are being taught.

There is only one doctrine in the Bible and that is the doctrine of the Apostles. **(Acts 2:42)** We must continue in the Apostles doctrine. **(1 Timothy 4:16)** The end result will be your salvation, your family's salvation, and the salvation of everyone who believes and obeys the message that Jesus gave to the Apostles. **(John 17:8,20)**

The Apostle Paul wrote an important warning to the Church that was in Rome. Paul told them to avoid people that caused confusion and division contrary to the Apostles' doctrine. **(Romans 16:17)**

Paul also admonished Timothy to teach **NO** other doctrine. **(1 Timothy 1:3)** The Apostle Paul also told the Galatians to follow **NO** other Gospel. In fact, Paul told them that there is no other Gospel. **(Galatians 1:6-9)**

The Apostle John made a very important statement in **1 John 4:6**. He said he that knows God, hears the words of the Apostles. This is how we can know the difference between what is true and right and what is wrong and untrue. He that contends for what the Apostles taught contends for the faith that was once delivered to the saints; for there is no other Gospel. **(Jude 3,17)**

Conclusion

The Apostle Paul wrote to the Church at Ephesus about the remedy for the cancer of sin. **(Ephesians 2:1,5)** We had a death sentence on us when Jesus found us, but Jesus took our sins and nailed them to His cross. **(Colossians 2:13-14)**

The cancer of sin is healed by the effect of the Blood of Jesus Christ on the Cross. When we are baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ, the blood that Jesus shed for the remission of our sins is applied to our lives. We are healed from the cancer of sin. **(1 Peter 2:24)**

The remedy for the cancer of sin is the blood of Jesus Christ.

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
