in front of the camera

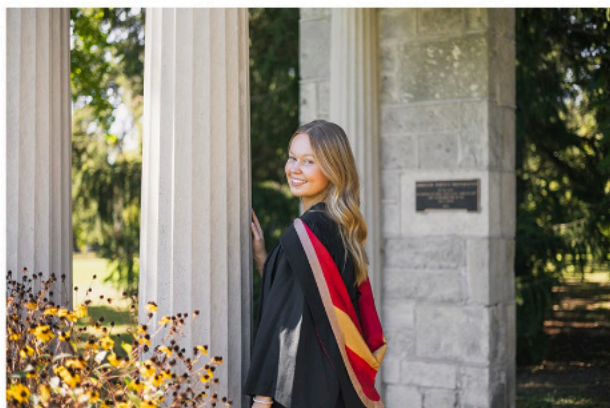

The Portico

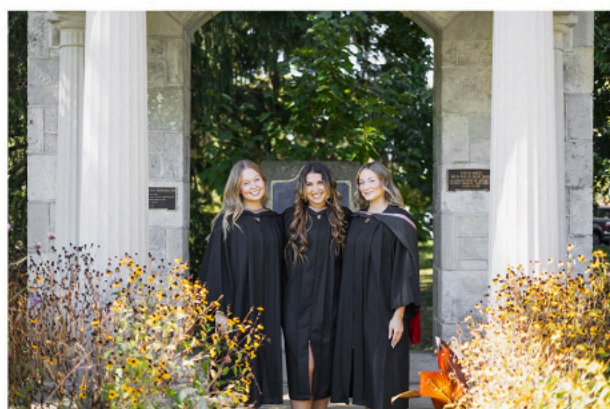
Face column, one hand on and look over shoulder



2. Lean back on column, cross arms



3. Group Photo



Alumni Walk Poses

Solo, in middle of path (sash & no sash)



2. Turn to one side (fav side) + look over sholder

3. Model walk towards camea and strike pose



4. Just sash over sholder

5. Doubles, rotate through group, standard smile, look at eachother and laugh, silly one

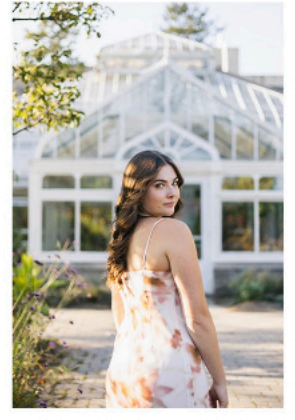
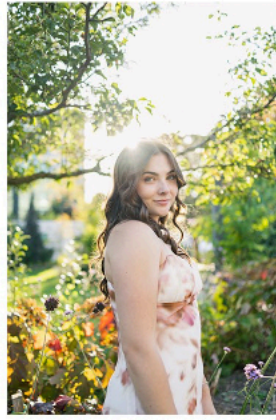


6. Group photos, (some with sash + gown)

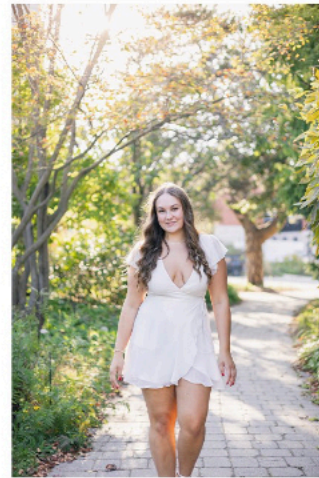


The Green House
