Subcontractor shall furnish all labor and equipment to perform the operations necessary to complete all landscaping work (supply & install) as indicated on the Contract Documents and specified herein, including but not limited to the following.

- 3. Contractor shall furnish all landscaping materials (trees, shrubs, groundcover, and turf) in accordance with the planting schedule, species, container sizes, and quantities shown on the approved landscape plans.
- 4. Subcontractor shall guarantee all plant materials for 30 days. The irrigation system shall be guaranteed for 1 year from time of acceptance by the Owner.
- 5. Subcontractor shall supply and install all chase pipes as needed under driveways and walkways before concrete/asphalt is poured.
- 6. Subcontractor shall supply and install irrigation control per plan with rain sensor.
- 7. All planter areas shall be irrigated by polyethylene tubing.
- 8. No high-water usage plants shall be permitted.
- 9. Subcontractor shall wash and/or sweep clean all walks, streets, and gutters when landscape operations are complete.
- 10. Subcontractor shall clean up and haul off all scrap material and waste created by landscape operations.
- 11. Subcontractor shall be responsible for landscape maintenance for 30 days after final acceptance by the Owner.

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- 12. Price includes all labor, materials, equipment, and services necessary to install all landscaping in accordance with the approved plans.

1.GENERAL:

- **A.** Reference to Subcontractor shall mean **Landscaping Subcontractor**. Reference to Owner shall mean Geahi, Inc.
- B. Subcontractor is responsible to check Contract and Approved Plans for any changes before construction

2. SCOPE:

- A. Subcontractor shall furnish all labor and equipment to perform the operations necessary to complete all landscaping operations as indicated on the drawings and specified herein, including but not necessarily limited to the following:
- B. All work shall conform to the approved Landscape Plan, Sheet L1-0 dated April 9, 2024, including plant species, container sizes, quantities, and layout as shown in the planting schedule. Any substitutions or deviations must be approved in writing by the Owner and Landscape Architect.
- C. Subcontractor shall furnish all labor, material, and equipment to perform all operations necessary to complete the installation of all landscaping per City or Governing Agency specifications with Owner's approval.
- D. Subcontractor shall furnish all trees, shrubs, groundcover, turf, and other landscape materials in accordance with the approved planting schedule and legend shown on the landscape drawings.
- E. Subcontractor shall guarantee all sod and plant materials for 60 days. The irrigation system shall be guaranteed for 1 year from the time of acceptance by the Owner.
- F. Subcontractor shall supply all chase pipes as needed under driveways and walkways before concrete is poured.
- G. Fertilizer tablets shall be provided for all trees and shrubs.
- H. Pre-emergent weed control shall be applied in all shrub beds.
- I. All planter areas shall be irrigated by drip irrigation using polyethylene tubing. All control valves shall be pressure-regulated. The irrigation system shall have manual shut-off valve(s).
- J. Subcontractor shall furnish and install a backflow preventer with protective cage and concrete pad, as well as an automatic irrigation controller with rain sensor, in accordance with the irrigation plan and governing agency requirements.
- K. Subcontractor shall wash and/or sweep clean all walks, streets, and gutters upon completion of landscape operations.
- L. Subcontractor shall clean up and haul off daily all scrap material and waste created by landscape operations.
- M. Subcontractor shall be responsible for complete landscape maintenance for a period of 30 days after final acceptance by the Owner.
- N. The irrigation system shall have manual shut-off valve(s) installed where applicable.
- O. All trenches shall be properly compacted per code and plan specifications.
- P. Subcontractor shall replace all dead plants and shrubs within 30 days of installation.
- Q. Landscape areas shall be protected at all times against damage during construction.
- R. Subcontractor shall coordinate with the General Contractor and other site trades to avoid conflicts with utilities, hardscape, and structures.
- S. Subcontractor shall schedule a final walkthrough with the Owner or Owner's Representative for landscape punch list approval prior to final acceptance and commencement of the maintenance period.
