## IMPORTANT SELLER INFORMATION CATALOG SALE

- 1. Catalog deadline December 10<sup>th</sup>.
- 2. Catalog fee \$125 per head. No PO fee. No fee to preview. Horses consigned by December 3<sup>rd</sup> will receive an early bird special catalog fee of \$100. All consignors will receive one ticket per horse to be entered into our Trent Ward saddle raffle. Sale order will be determined by draw.
- 3. Preview 10am. Sale 2pm. Check in will be available Friday evening from 4-9 pm and will begin Saturday at 8 am. It is your responsibility to get your horse to and from the sale ring at its designated time to sell. You will be assigned a pen prior to your arrival. Please bring any water buckets and feed you will need to care for your horse while on-site.
- 4. Commission is 10% of the gross sale price.
- 5. Must have pictures to consign to catalog. Video is optional.
  - The option is available to have a video play in the ring. Video must be provided in the form of a YouTube link and must be turned in by the Thursday prior to the sale. Please MUTE videos, NO music.
- 6. All horses consigned to the catalog must sell sound with a 72-hour guarantee, NO EXCEPTIONS. It is the consignor's responsibility to disclose any impairments, imperfections, or invasive surgeries applicable to the horse. Sound by the definition of Anderson County Livestock Exchange means: Moving free of a limp on all four legs. Can see out of both eyes. Does not crib (suck wind), does not weave, and is not proud cut.
- 7. Original registration certificate & completed transfer must accompany registered horses at the time of check in. A current negative coggins test is required for your horse to sell. There will be a vet on-site to pull coggins at the rate of \$35. Horses entering the grounds from out of state must have an Equine Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (health certificate) less than 30 days old.
- 8. Checks to consignors will be mailed out 3 full business days after the sale.
- 9. Anderson County Horse Sale (Anderson County Livestock Exchange) merely acts as auctioneer to all sales. We are not responsible to any error, misunderstanding, misrepresentation, rejections, condition of the horse, or any other dispute between the buyer and the seller.
- 10. Consigned horses may not be sold through private sale. Should a consigned horse be sold through private sale the catalog fee of \$125, 10% of the total sale price and a \$300 early withdraw fee will be due to the sale company and you will be asked not to return. If a consigned horse is withdrawn from the sale for any reason other than infirmity or private sale the catalog fee of \$125 in addition to a \$300 early withdraw fee will be due to the sale company. Should a consigned horse need to be pulled from the catalog due to injury or sickness video/picture proof must be provided. If you cannot provide proof of a legitimate reason for pulling from the catalog you are still due your fees to the sale company. Anderson County Livestock Exchange reserves the right to bill consignors for catalog fees or unpaid commission under the above stated circumstances.
- 11. The best of possible care will be taken to maintain our facilities for the safety of the horses on-site, but ACLE/Anderson County Horse Sale will not be responsible for any sickness or accident to horses. Ride and sell at your own risk.
