Terms & Conditions CATALOG SALE

- 1. Catalog deadline July 9th.
- 2. Preview 10 AM, Catalog sale begins at 2 PM with non-catalog to follow.
- Catalog fee \$125 per head. No PO fee. No fee to preview. Horses consigned by July 2nd will receive an <u>early</u> <u>bird special catalog fee of \$100</u>. All consignors will receive one FREE TICKET per horse to be entered into our SADDLE RAFFLE.
- 4. Commission is 10% of the gross sale price.
- 5. Must have pictures to consign to catalog. Video is optional.
 - Videos will be posted on Social Media and play by the sale ring on sale day. Video must be provided in the form of a YouTube link and must be turned in by the Thursday prior to the sale. Please mute videos, no music.
- 6. A current negative coggins test is required for your horse to sell. There will be a vet on-site to pull coggins at the rate of \$45. Horses entering the grounds from out of state must have an Equine Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (health certificate) less than 30 days old.
- 7. All horses consigned to the catalog must sell sound with a 72-hour guarantee unless otherwise clearly stated by the seller. It is the consignor's responsibility to disclose any impairments, imperfections, unsoundness, or invasive surgeries applicable to the horse. Sound by the definition of Anderson County Livestock Exchange means: Moving free of a limp on all four legs as viewed by external examination. Can see out of both eyes. Good in the air. Does not crib (suck wind), does not weave, and is not proud cut.
- 8. Checks to consignors will be mailed out 3 full business days after the sale.
- 9. Anderson County Horse Sale (Anderson County Livestock Exchange) merely acts as auctioneer to all sales. We are not responsible to any error, misunderstanding, misrepresentation, rejections, condition of the horse, or any other dispute between the buyer and the seller.
- 10. After a horse is consigned and listed on social media, Consignor agrees not to dispose of the horse by private sale. Withdrawals will be permitted in hardship cases but must be presented to sale office with proof that the horse is either not sound, or had an injury, is ill or dead. Proof of hardship may be submitted with a veterinarian letter, video or picture. If you cannot provide proof of a legitimate reason for pulling from the catalog you will owe a \$250 withdrawal fee in addition with your initial catalog fee to the Sale Barn.
- 11. Anderson County Livestock Exchange reserves the right to bill consignors for catalog fee or unpaid commission under the above stated circumstances.
