



Goodwin Avenue (County Road 85) Bridge Replacement

What's Being Done?

Dakota County will replace the bridge over the Vermillion River on Goodwin Avenue 1 mile north of County Road 62 (190th Street).

When Will Work Take Place?

Road work is scheduled to begin July 14, 2026. Construction will begin with setting up traffic control, installing erosion control, and removing the existing bridge.

Traffic control devices and warnings will be placed in advance for the detour during construction. Driveway access for residences will remain open during construction from each side of the bridge. No traffic will be allowed through the construction area.

The detour will use County Road 62 (190th St), County Road 47 (Northfield Blvd), and County Road 46 (160th St) to get around the bridge closure. Further detour information will be available soon on the project webpage.
