~The Extended Scholarship Program

A limited number of extended scholarships are now available. The purpose of the extended scholarship program is to support our recipients in achieving their career goals if further assistance is needed beyond the original awards. Not all applicants will be granted extended scholarships. **NOTE: Only ONE extended scholarship can be awarded per person. Do not apply if you have already received an extended scholarship.**

The extended scholarship award is \$1000.00.

- It is made with proof of financial need in order to pursue continued enrollment in college/trade school.
- The payment will require evidence that the applicant has successfully completed the following:
 - o A completed application for the extended scholarship grant
 - o At least two terms of college, with a minimum of 18 units leading to a degree in her/his stated profession, and maintaining an overall 2.0 GPA

OR

- Successful progress in the vocational/trade program for which he/she received the original scholarship
- o Proof of continued enrollment in the college or program

How To Qualify For This Scholarship

All applicants must have received the first two installments of the regular scholarship program, must show progress toward their stated profession, and must demonstrate continued financial need to complete the vocational program for which they have been training.

Application Package Instructions

- 1. Complete the application form.
- 2. Provide college *official* transcripts showing a minimum of 18 units completed leading to a degree in your stated profession with a total GPA of 2.0 or better. For those enrolled in a vocational program, you must verify your successful progress toward its completion.
- 3. Provide a career statement (approximately 100 words), stating how your post-high school training has affected your aspirations and career ambitions and how further financial assistance from the Hunter Foundation can help to bring these dreams to reality.
- 4. **Send all application materials to the Hunter Foundation at 13502 Whittier Blvd, Ste. H** #342, Whittier, California 90605. We review extended scholarship applications twice a year: in September and January. To qualify for consideration in September, applications must be received by August 15. To qualify for consideration in January, applications must be received by January 7.

Frequently Asked Questions

Who is eligible to apply and receive this award? Recipients of the Dorothy P. and Howard D. Hunter Scholarship who have received the first two awards with a minimum 18 units completed, have maintained a grade point average of 2.0 or its equivalent throughout their training or college coursework and who continue to have need of financial assistance to complete their studies.

What vocational career programs qualify for this scholarship? Any careers that might be considered vocational in nature. Examples of qualifying programs include: Accounting, Animal Care, Animation, Architecture, Automotive Technology, Aviation Maintenance, Computer Programming, Construction Contracting, Cosmetology, Criminal Justice, Culinary Arts, Design -- (Fashion, Graphic, or Industrial), Early Child Development, Engineering, Environmental Technologies, Film & TV Technologies, Healthcare -- (Nursing, Medical & Dental Assistants, Physical Therapy, Medical Billing, etc.), Hotel Management/Hospitality, Paralegal Studies, Plumbing, Real Estate, Software Engineering, Tool and Die Manufacturing, Water Management, Welding. If I send in a completed application, am I guaranteed to get the extended scholarship? Awards will be determined on an individual basis and are not guaranteed.

How much is the scholarship and how is it paid out? \$1000 is paid upon proof of continued enrollment in the college/trade school study of your career choice. The recipient must be enrolled in a minimum of 9 units and GPA of 2.0 or show continuing successful progress in a trade school curriculum.

How do I apply? Download and print out the application packet. Complete the application, the statement of career interest, and provide college/trade school transcripts as outlined in the information packet. Submit the completed packet to the Dorothy P. Hunter Foundation at 13502 Whittier Blvd, Ste. H #342, Whittier CA 90605.

How many times can I apply for an extended scholarship?

Each regular scholarship recipient may receive ONE extended scholarship, upon approval of the Board. Not all applicants will be granted extended scholarships.

Will my personal information be secure?
