Eligible Students For The Program

- ❖ Must be graduating from a WUHSD high school in June 2025.
- ❖ Must have a minimum 2.0 grade point average (GPA) upon graduation.
- ❖ Must demonstrate interest and skill for a vocational trade or related career.
- ❖ Must be planning to enroll in a college, community college or pursue vocational training to further prepare for their career no later than February 1, 2026.

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The Program

The purpose of the scholarship program is to encourage and assist graduating students from the Whittier Union High School District (WUHSD) to become career ready by obtaining either a certificate of achievement or completion from a trade school or college credits leading to a vocational career.

The scholarship award is \$2000, paid out in two installments.

- The first installment (\$1000) is made with proof of enrollment in college/trade school with a minimum of 9 units or its equivalent.
- The second payment (\$1000) will require the student to provide official transcripts showing completion of the following:
 - The first term of college or community college, with a minimum of 9 units, maintaining a 2.0 GPA or
 - o The satisfactory completion of the first half of a skilled-trade program
 - o Proof of continued enrollment in the program

How To Qualify For This Scholarship

- Must be a graduating senior in the Whittier Union High School District
- Must have an overall GPA of 2.0 or above
- The student will be entering a vocational training program at a college, community college or skilled-trade school by **February 1, 2026.**
- This program should prepare the student for immediate entry into the workforce in their chosen field.

Application Package Instructions

- 1. Complete the application form. Online application is available at dorothyhdhunterfoundation.org.
- 2. Provide letters of recommendation from two individuals who are not related to you.
- 3. Provide a career statement (should be a minimum of 100 words), outlining why you chose the career you wish to follow and the school you plan to attend (form included).
- 4. Provide official transcript.
- 5. Turn in all application materials to the designated contact person at your school or submit online by March 20, 2025.
