Request for Appeal

Comes Now, Jah Rastafari Malchizedek, the petitioner in true **Sovereign** form, with this Request for Appeal to the highest court in the land for a review of this court's decision not to allow Petitioner His godly right to be heard according to common Law, in light of newly discovered evidence obtain since His released from custody on November 6, 2023 (in Ref. to Case No. 16-8725-CF10A) which was/is in question for review with regards to the unlawful charges His 28 U.S.C. § 2241 **Habeas Petition** (Case No. 17-CV-60008) addressed, which this Court erroneously closed as well.
