IELTS - How we teach

Strategies and Techniques - We ensure our students are well versed with the best techniques and strategies when it comes to answering all question types on the IELTS test. Ranging from how to tackle maps in listening to writing grammatically correct essays, we ensure our students better understand each tip and trick before writing the final Test.

Topics - We handle one topic at a time. This gives us the clarity and ability to bring about the desired change in a student's performance in their weak and strong areas. There are separate test papers and question banks provided to students for each topic.

Practice Papers - We provide our students with latest practise test papers. These test papers are often organised in increasing levels of difficulty. We also curate test papers which test students on the most frequently asked questions as well as the most unexpected questions.

Pedagogy



1st phase. We always begin with a thorough analysis of a student's strengths and weaknesses. Based on the initial assessment we carefully draft a plan where we begin with revisiting the basics and explaining the need of the test. First few days are spent on strengthening the weak areas.



In the 2nd phase we increase the difficulty level and share tons of question banks so that the student quickly gets into the right frame of mind and rhythm which is in sync with the test. Intention of this phase is to cover all question types so that no topic emerges as a surprise for the student. Also, the difficulty level is at par with the test.



In the final phase, we stress more on practise tests. We assist student's in scoring as high as possible by giving them test papers of varied difficulty on a regular basis. This phase is filled with Q&A sessions and mock tests. We aim to ensure we maximise a student's potential.



Reading  The reading component consist of two parts one is Academic and other one is General, as mostly students opt for Academic the pattern is expounded below but in General IELTS the Candidate has to undergo easier reading session which are generally of lower standard

Writing:  The writing component consist of two parts one is Academic and other one is General, as mostly students opt for Academic pattern which is bit tough but in General IELTS the Candidate has to undergo Letter writing session. Task Two carries more weight in your final band score than Task One. Remember that illegible handwriting will reduce your final score.

Speaking:  The IELTS speaking test takes around 11 to 15 minutes and is in the form of an interview. The interview will most probably seem like a friendly conversation which typically covers some aspects of your past, present and future situations.

Listening:  The IELTS listening test takes approximately 30 minutes. The listening material is recorded on a cassette tape/ CD/ DVD which you will hear only once. At the end of the recorded material you will be given ten minutes to copy your answers in to the answer sheet.
