No entries will be accepted by phone, or fax, or email except as detailed below. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary’s address. Inquiries may be directed to Judi James at rainspring.mdg@gmail.com. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Electronic entries will be accepted prior to the closing date. The following instructions **MUST** be followed:

1. Complete the entry form and tally the fee for each form. Go to paypal.com and follow the instructions to “Send Money” to rainspring.mdg@gmail.com Make the payment for required entry fee plus a **\$5 handling fee** per entry form. Write the transaction ID number on the entry.
2. Sign the completed entry form, then email to rainspring.mdg@gmail.com.

Returned Checks/Declined Transactions The Trial Secretary will add a \$25 service charge for any returned check or declined PayPal transaction. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in being placed on a CASH ONLY basis.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

ALL checks received will be deposited and must clear to be considered a valid entry.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

Greater Clark County Kennel Club offers a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of **20 entries per trial** will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to closing date of **April 24, 2019**. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing date of April 24, 2019. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund. Refunds will be mailed after completion of the trial.

MOVE UPS/CLASS TRANSFERS between trials are allowed each day if received at least 30 minutes prior the start of each trial. Requests must be on a transfer form provided by the trial secretary. If your dog titles prior to Wednesday May 8, 2019 please mail or email Trial Secretary with the Dog name, breed, AKC number, Owner Name and your armband number if known so that is received by May 8, 2019. After that date, make your transfers at the event. The Trial Secretary will be on-site Friday May 10, 2019 1pm to 4 pm to accept class transfers. Address is listed on page 2 of this premium list. Phone transfers will not be accepted.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Females in season may not participate, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

Judges will do all levels offered in each assigned element at each trial. Trials will run consecutively. Afternoon trials will not start until morning trial is complete or the posted start time whichever is later.

HANDLER DISCRIMINATION DIVISON

Handler Discrimination classes are titling classes in which the targeted scent is that of the handlers themselves. **Handlers are required to provide their own scented articles in a plastic bag.** For the Novice class, one cotton glove or cotton sock, for Advanced, Excellent, and Master, cotton balls or cotton swabs. Three qualifying scores are required to earn titles in each class. Handlers may utilize any method they feel is best to **scent their article**. Suggestions include rubbing the article on the handler’s body or storing the item in dirty laundry.

STAGING AREA, HANDLER’S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include crating, warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results. The **Handlers Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handlers Briefing the judge will explain if there is an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handlers Briefing. A **warm-up area** will be available consisting of ONE marked container of each odor being tested at the trial and may also consist of blank containers. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to (2) two minutes or less. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior to their run, or for recovery after the run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search Area Conditions. Searches may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces.
Search Area Sizes Refer to the Scentwork Regulations for search area sizes and other requirements. Search areas may be of any shape and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Site. It is not appropriate to visit the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5, Section 26 of the Scent Work Regulations state “No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area”.

Spectator Area. Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be ask to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search until the completion of the class. *We recommend bringing your own chair to use at this site.*

Crating space will be available in the staging area. Crates may be left overnight; however, the **Greater Clark County KC, Pacific NW Scent Work Club, and Clark County Fairgrounds** will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

All prizes and ribbons must be claimed day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

A **New Title rosette** will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

High in Trial Teams earning High in Trial in each level will receive a HIT rosette.

Only teams who participate in all elements, in the same level, offered (Container, Interior, Exterior, Buried, and Handler Discrimination), and qualify in each element, are eligible to win **High in Trial**. One High in Trial winner is chosen for **each level**; there is not a separate High in Trial for the Novice A and Novice B sections.

The High in Trial is determined by adding each teams faults across the elements. If there is a tie based on faults, then each teams times across the elements will be summed and the faster-finishing team wins.

Exhibitors MUST check-in for each trial in which they are entered. If entered in both the morning and afternoon trials check in for each at the designated time. *Time listed on the face of this premium list are approximate and may change after entries close. Check schedule included with your entry confirmation to be sure.*

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Greater Clark County Kennel Club, Pacific NW Scent Work Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Greater Clark County Kennel Club & Pacific NW Scent Work Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Greater Clark County Kennel Club, Pacific NW Scent Work Club or any official thereof.

Dogs found in an Unsafe environment, distress or harm's way such as in a hot motor vehicle will be removed to safety by Club officials or security personnel. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way will be investigated by the Event Committee. All persons attending this event waive any claim for damages against the Clubs, their members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and **retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches)**. Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

Fire Lanes and designated areas must be kept clear. No parking in these areas.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. **Dogs pulled after closing** because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee less a \$5 per trial processing fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of each trial. Refunds will be mailed after completion of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the search area when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN At check-in you will receive your armband number. Once the time and location for check-in is determined all exhibitors will be notified by email.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Job Descriptions

*Note: many volunteer positions require walking, standing and bending. *May be sit down jobs.*

Chief Steward – organizes, trains, deploys volunteers throughout event. May also work the gate or score table.

Element Set up – Ensures all setup is complete for assigned Element, at the Judges direction, including line of site, start lines, boundary marking. *Friday & Saturday afternoon, Sunday morning*

Clean up – Site preparation for the next day, removal and loading of all trial gear at Trial(s) completion.

***Timer** – Timing competitor runs.

***Gate Steward** – Managing flow for the trial element area, assisting competitors positioning pre-search.

***Judges Steward** – Bring competitors to the start line, remind them of the time limit and leash options for the search.

Hide Steward (includes Hot Box Steward) *must wear latex or nitrile gloves when handling odor containers/boxes, etc. to prevent contamination*

Handles and places hides for each class, including moving or adjusting hides during a class **at the Judge's direction**. Handles/sets warmup boxes.

Cleanup between buried hide competitors may be required, including sweeping, vacuuming, or returning spilled soil or sand to the container.

Score Runner - carries score sheets from search areas to Score Table throughout the trial.

***Registration** – Check in of arriving Competitors and Volunteers. Assistance at Score Table with verification of score sheet completion before data entry.
