Entries close at 8 pm Pacific Time, Wednesday, March 4, 2020 or when entry limits are reached, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted, except as provided in Chapter 1, section 27 of the AKC Obedience Regulations or Chapter 1, Section 24 of the AKC Rally Regulations.

Changes, Additions or Corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by email prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Make all Checks or Money Orders payable in US Funds to My Dogs Gym. The Event Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Photocopied entries without the AKC agreement on the back or attached are NOT acceptable. Conditional, unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable. Returned checks or declined PayPal transactions do not constitute a valid entry fee.

Foreign Checks drawn on a foreign bank that uses a 9 digit routing number, even if in US Funds, must be accompanied by a \$10 processing fee in US Funds. If in doubt, please call Event Secretary before sending.

AKC FEES AKC assesses recording and event service fees that are included in the entry fee and paid to AKC. Each Rally entry includes an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.50 for first class, \$3 each additional class. See AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 4.

Returned Checks/Declined Transactions The Event Secretary will add a \$25 service charge for each returned check or declined credit card transaction. Subsequent invalid payments from the same exhibitor may result in being placed on a CASH ONLY basis.

Refunds Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience, Rally or Junior Showmanship. If a bitch is withdrawn from such competition because she came into season and trial secretary is notified in writing at least one-half hour prior to the start of the event, the club will refund entries withdrawn under this section, but may retain \$5 per class fee. See AKC Obedience Regulations Chapter 1, Section 14 and Rally Regulations Chapter 1, Section 13.

Move-ups & transfers will be accepted for these obedience and rally trials but must be received by the trial secretary no later than Wednesday March 18, 2020 if mailed. After that time, please email move-up information to the Secretary by Thursday March 19, 2020. Hand delivered move-ups will be accepted until 30 minutes prior to the start of the judging each day.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned

parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
