

Who Wants to Go To Fiddle Camp?

The Northeast Fiddlers Association (NEFA), will offer a full tuition scholarship to a Vermont Fiddler at one of these camps in the summer of 2020: The Northeast Heritage Music Camp; The Maine Fiddle Camp; Ashokan Fiddle and Dance; or the Acadia Trad Fest. For younger fiddlers (Ages 7 to mid-teens) to one of these: the Young Tradition Vermont Trad Camp; the Summit School Trad Camp; or the Brattleboro Music Center's Summer Trad Camp. Each of these camps offers a week of classes, workshops and jamming with exciting and inspirational teachers.

An application fee of \$15 gives the applicant a one-year membership in NEFA.

The applicant must attend and participate in at least one of the first 4 NEFA meets in 2020.
