SWIRLTEX INC. Welcomes Dr. John Paulos to Board of Directors. He is an active angel investor and former Board Chair of the Central Texas Angel Network. Over the past decade, he has invested in more than 70 companies, including two unicorns.

AMPLIFIED SCIENCES has been named a 2025 TechPoint Mira Awards Finalist in the BioCrossroads Life Sciences Innovation Team of the Year Award category.

REALSEQ BIOSCIENCES has entered a strategic service agreement with Tropic. The agreement aims to leverage RealSeq's advanced RNA sequencing technologies to support Tropic's efforts in developing novel solutions for crop improvement and plant health.

HEALIONICS's STARgraft was granted Breakthrough Device Designation by the US FDA, and was invited to join their new Total Product Life Cycle Advisory Program (TAP). HINALEA IMAGING. provides intelligent imaging solutions combining hyperspectral imaging with advanced neural network-powered analytics systems for quality assurance, testing and inspection applications. Applications include in-line inspection of products for quality and safety (notably food), medical diagnostics, and precision agriculture. As part of its solution offering, Hinalaea developed the world's first high-resolution, handheld autonomous hyperspectral camera, which was awarded the SPIE Best Camera and Imager Prism Award.
